FIGHTING STILL CONTINUES.

Generals Vasquez and Godoy took the offensive against the insurgents, and sent their infantry against the enemy's position. The result of the fighting is not yet known, nor the number of casualties.

COMMISSION TO BE FOUND.

FREDERICTON, N.B., Feb. 19.—An important event in the Legislature here was the introduction of a Government Bill for the control of Public Utility Corporations. The Bill, which is modelled after the Nova Scotia act, provides for the appointment of an independent commission before whom utility companies must file tariffs and statements and justify proposed increases in rate before they can be applied.
