**REPORT OF G.W.P.  
 REV. E. S. WEEKS**

 in which dwells the lofty spirit of true patriotism, is against it. This being so the threatened interests of the rum trade are organized with greater vigour than ever before and they are exercising their best tactics.  
 In England, in Ireland and in Scotland a great temperance awakening is observed, while in Australia and in other far away lands the temperance movement never before received anything like the place it now occupies in the thought of the people.  
 To the south of us, in the domain of Uncle Sam, the results that are attending the efforts in the direction of prohibitory legislation are simply phenomenal. State after state is being pronounced "dry," and temperance advocates are exultant.  
 In our own great Dominion good news is coming from every quarter. Marked advancement is being made and a renewed interest is being aroused. In Ontario most pronounced progress has been made, and excellent results are following the course of temperance workers. In Quebec there is a bestirring, (unparalleled in forty years) to aggressive action such as may well be admired.  
 In N.S. and N. B. the work of temperance reform is assuming most encouraging proportions.  
 Indeed from the Atlantic to the Pacific there is a mighty revival in respect to the need of dealing with the liquor evil with ungloried hands. In this Province we may be pardoned for believing that the example we have set as touching Prohibitory measures, has had some influence on other sections of this dominion. Just how much we cannot know, but it is true the straits have not shut our influence off from other places.  
 But ere we had time to even rest from that toil which has reaped Prohibition for us, the emissaries of the accursed traffic were at work plying their nefarious trade with all the ingenuity of the denizens of his satanic majesty. These agents in some cases appear today in the garb of druggists and medical practitioners, and thus degrade their noble professions.  
 The only thing we can do at present is to work our law for all it is worth, and put all the machinery for its enforcement into vigorous action. But, then, some of the "machinery" needs careful watching—especially is this true in Kings County and in the greater part of Prince County. We want to see every inspector doing his duty—his whole duty, irrespective of the political color or the creed of offender against the law.  
 In regard to the jurisdiction of our Grand Division it is encouraging to note that the order is in a most healthy and prosperous condition. A large number of subordinate Divisions has reported to date. This speaks a good interest in the work, when it is remembered that much bad travelling has been experienced during the past quarter.  
 A large number of public temperance meetings has been held, and these cannot fail of good.  
 I have received reports from some Divisions. Bro. Sellick, deputy of "Refuge" Division, has sent me a carefully prepared report in which he reviews the work of the past quarter and pronounces, in warm terms, the worthy place "Refuge" holds in the ranks of our order.  
 Bro. Wm. S. McNeill reports for "Bellevue" Division and speaks of success attending it.  
 Bro. Shaw reports for "Steadfast" Division, etc. Many of the Deputies have reported to the Grand Scribe.  
 During the past quarter I have been able, (notwithstanding the many pastoral duties claiming my time) to visit several subordinate Divisions. I was warmly welcomed in "Union" Division and found prosperity marking the efforts there. At "Refuge" Division a large number was in attendance, on the occasion of my visit. This Division is composed of nearly all young people and yet the constitution is closely followed and the business carefully transacted, while the program can match the best to be found in any Division in the Province.  
 At "Burns" Division, Tyne Valley, the attendance was not large but a good meeting was conducted and determination to fight on characterized the members generally.  
 In Fort Hill Division is to be found some of the very best material in our order. I addressed a large public temperance gathering at Fort Hill on Feb'y 3rd, and also attended the Annual Session of District
