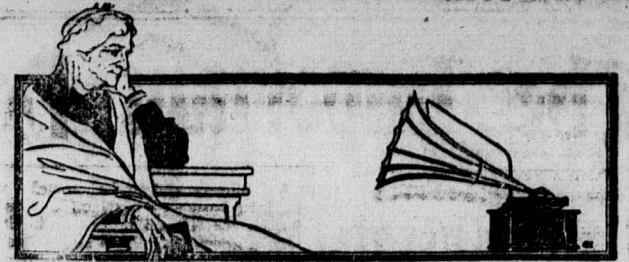
Are people who are not seeking for revelations, likely to have them?

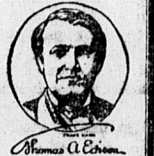

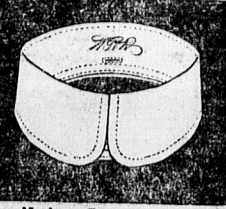
