### Oatmeal Bread

With one quart of boiling water scald two cupsful of Tillson's Rolled Oats. Add one tablespoonful of salt and one of oil. When cool, add one yeast cake dissolved in one cupful lukewarm water, and three cupfuls bread flour, or enough to make a batter. Beat well. When light add one-half teaspoonful soda dissolved in a very little warm water, and one-half cupful of sugar. Beat eight cupfuls of flour into the batter, making the bread as stiff as can be stirred. It may take more than the amount of flour, which should be added gradually, beating and stirring continually. Turn into the tins, let rise, and bake one hour in a slow oven.
