LESSON V. FEBRUARY 4.
THE WISE MEN LED BY THE STAR.
Matt. 2: 1-12.
GOLDEN TEXT.
"Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else."—Isa. 45: 22.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.
By Rev. D. W. Snider.

The wondrous birth of Jesus was made significant and illustrious in the annals of history by the worshipful testimony and ministry of angels and of men of nature. The lonely place where Jesus lay was not passed by, but it rather became the trying place for worship of the choicest representatives of earth and sky; angels, magi and stars.

"Too much cannot be made of the solid historic basis which the lesson suggests and presents for the birth of Jesus and of the divine significance of it for the race. Prophetic statement and Roman history and astral phenomena combine to make place and name and date secure.

Learning at its best is a worshipper. It is always limited but it is never without its "gleam." And God keeps the star of guidance over the place of worship until it comes to pass that the truth-seeker is ever seeking God. Those who forsake the search of truth to linger among the shops and bazars and sports of Jerusalem lose the star and fail to find the King. They stay where Herod is, and miss the Christ.

The gospel exhortation and the Master's promise that men should seek and knock and ask, and that if they do so they shall find, has an illustration of such a splendid quality in the lesson that one ought to lay its message to heart. Trace the seeking, searching magi upon their four months' quest for the One "that is born King of the Jews," noting their devout intention by the offerings they carry, and let some illumination and power teach what it means, the beauty and the strength of it, to seek the Lord. Thank God, He is to be found.

Poor, shortsighted, jealous visioned Herod. And he keeps his sight short, and his soul aflame until the fires of cruelty leap and destroy because his parasitic lust for power is circumscribed by the glory of Rome. He cannot see that his position might be heightened and widened to the reach of a glory that excelled by laying his crown at Jesus' feet. He is the dupe of tinsel and trappings. The magi were the seekers of a truth, a reality, a spiritual kingship through a God-given king who should embody and enthroned the Desire of all nations.

Avea, population, significant or fertile location, resources of natural beauty or products do not give abiding fame to a place nor create greatness. Canadian provinces in their rivalry and Canadian cities in their pride of growth have this lesson to learn. Jesus was born in Bethlehem, and it was great because out of it came "forth a governor." What kind of men are being reared in your town?

Lost guidance which has been restored is matter for rejoicing. When the young man let his heart's eyes fall from the star guidance of his mother's love and prayers he lost something over which he may well rejoice when he finds it again.

Nothing but the best is worthy to be offered to Jesus, or to be chosen as symbolic of the worship of the soul, or as giving proof of it. The one who thinks he can worship without bringing an offering has cheated his soul. He feels no one else.

The wise men from the East of whom the lesson speaks are not the only ones whom God has warned away from designing and evil men. Alas, that many fail to hear the warning.

If Returned as Chief Magistrate

FIRST. I shall in every way encourage the establishment of new industries and will appoint five councillors to be designated the Industrial Committee whose duty will be principally to make enquiries, and if necessary take steps to induce means of means to establish works that will give employment to our citizens

SECOND. My attention will be given to the good work of laying concrete sidewalks and the macadamizing streets, thereby improving our City and employing our working men.

THIRD. From observation and enquiries made while visiting other cities I am convinced that with the co-operation of the Light & Power Company our streets can be much better lighted at no more expense to the City with the exception of a little extra for lamp posts which could be manufactured in one of our City establishments by our own mechanics.

FOURTH. A Provincial Government have placed upon the Citizens very heavy taxes for which we receive very little benefit. I shall make an effort to secure a just and reasonable share of the revenue, and if successful the amount should be expended on permanent improvement.

FIFTH. The general health and sanitary condition of the City will have my careful attention.

SIXTH. In almost all well regulated Cities, hospitals and charitable institutions receive assistance from the public treasurer. In this respect our past City Councils have failed in doing their duty. In order to be in line with other cities I propose cancelling the Mayor's salary and special placing the amount on the estimate as follows:—

Tuberculosis Society \$50.00
Poor Fund for coal etc. \$50.00
Ch'town Hospital. \$50.00
P. E. I. Hospital. \$50.00
Mt. Herbert Orphanage \$50.00
St. Dunstan's Orphanage \$50.00
The balance. \$24.44 to be divided in equal parts for prizes between the three public schools, Prince Street, St. Patrick, and West Kent.

These with all other matters pertaining to the welfare of the City will have my special attention.
