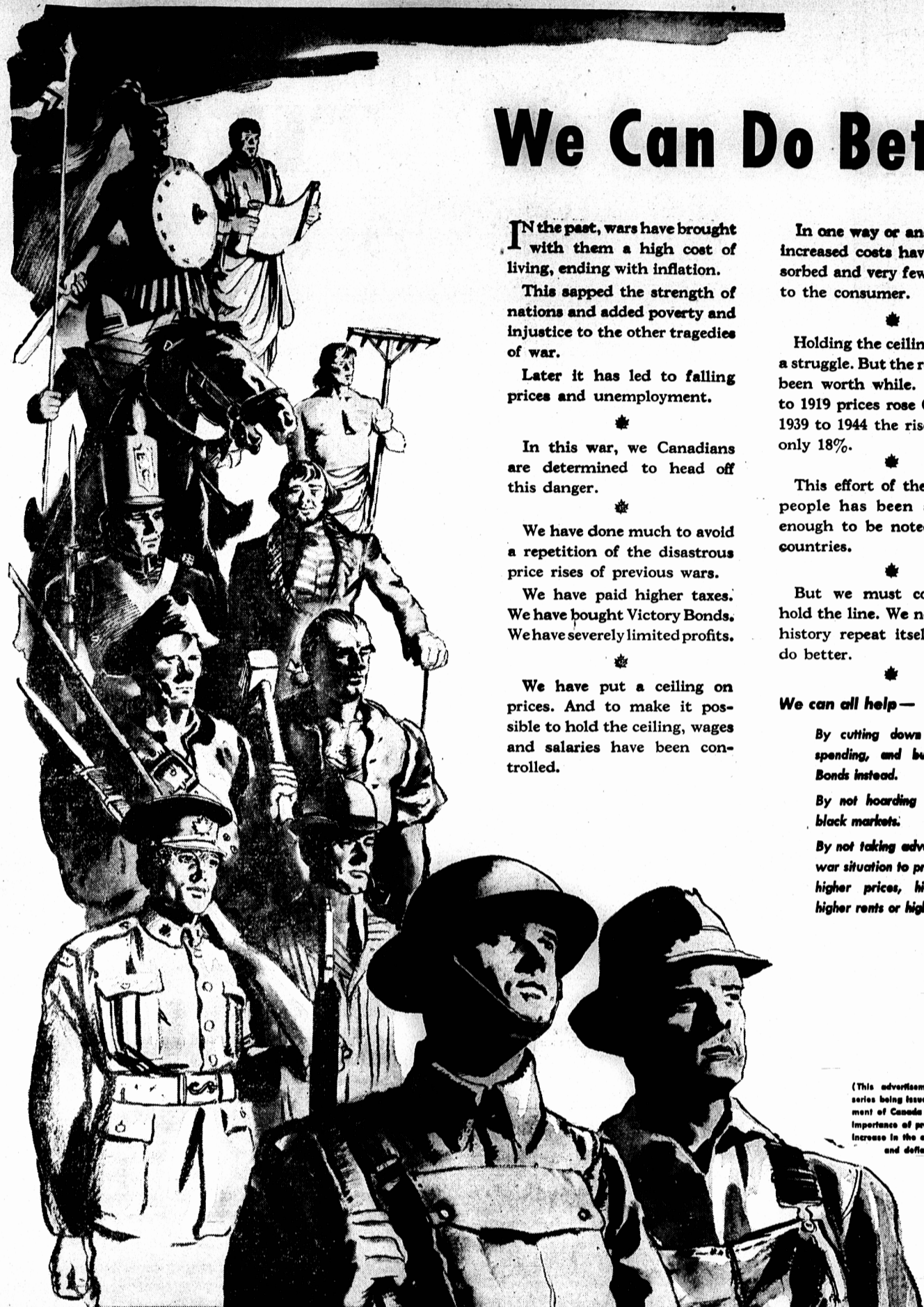

We Can Do Better

IN the past, wars have brought with them a high cost of living, ending with inflation. This sapped the strength of nations and added poverty and injustice to the other tragedies of war. Later it has led to falling prices and unemployment. In this war, we Canadians are determined to head off this danger. We have done much to avoid a repetition of the disastrous price rises of previous wars. We have paid higher taxes. We have bought Victory Bonds. We have severely limited profits. We have put a ceiling on prices. And to make it possible to hold the ceiling, wages and salaries have been controlled.

In one way or another most increased costs have been absorbed and very few passed on to the consumer. Holding the ceiling has been a struggle. But the results have been worth while. From 1914 to 1919 prices rose 60%. From 1939 to 1944 the rise has been only 18%. This effort of the Canadian people has been successful enough to be noted in other countries. But we must continue to hold the line. We need not let history repeat itself. We can do better. We can all help—

By cutting down unnecessary spending, and buying Victory Bonds instead. By not hoarding or buying in black markets. By not taking advantage of the war situation to press claims for higher prices, higher wages, higher rents or higher profits.
