Livestock

MONTREAL, Dec. 12-(CP)-All classes of livestock were steady today on the Montreal livestock market, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported.
Receipts were 162 cattle, 123 sheep and lambs, 824 hogs and 488 calves.
One carload of good western cows were sold late yesterday at \$5.35. Today's receipts were made up of common to just plan quality cows. A few medium quality cows made \$4.25 to \$5, with common butchers from \$3.50 to \$4. Canners and cutters ranged from \$2.50 to \$3.25, mostly \$2.75 to \$3.25. Common butts \$3.50 to \$4.25.
Veal calves were firm at \$8 for common light veals to \$11 for good kinds, and with a couple top veals at \$11.50. The bulk of the veal calves were sold around \$10. Drinkers were \$6 to \$8. Grassers made the bulk of the offerings and were lacking in quality. Prices ranged from \$4.75 to \$5.25 mostly \$4.75 to \$5.
Good ewes and wethers were \$10. When graded, heavy lambs were cut \$1 per cwt. Culls and bucks were cut \$2 per cwt. Several small lots were sold on a flat basis at \$9.25. Sheep were from \$4 to \$5.50.
Bacon hogs were mostly \$9.25 fed and watered and \$9.35 off trucks. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular cuts on off grades. Sows were \$6.25 to \$7. Hogs sold on rail grade brought \$12.30 hot weight.

GRAIN

CHICAGO, Dec. 12-(AP)-The southwestern wheat belt drought, stimulated buying of wheat futures today that lifted prices more than a cent a bushel at times.
Although prices fluctuated nervously at times, wheat closed 5-8 -1-4 higher than yesterday, Dec 88-99 1-8, May 95-95 1-8; Corn unchanged to 1-4 lower, Dec 53 3-4, May 55 1-4-3-8; Oats unchanged to 1-4 lower.
WINNIPEG, Dec. 12-(CP)-Wheat prices advanced a cent on the Winnipeg futures market today as buyers responded to bullish reports from the Argentine new crop areas and the winter wheat belt of the United States.
Final quotations were 1-1 1-8 cent higher, with Dec wheat at 85-8 cents a bushel May 84 7-8-85 and July 86 cents. Offerings remained light and only moderate buying by export interests, southern traders and commission houses was necessary to boost quotations.
Buenos Aires wheat quotations were up 1 3-8-1 1-4 cent.

FINANCE

NEW YORK, Dec. 12-(AP)-Securities markets today took a back seat in favor of commodities. The share list displayed a slightly downward tilt at the start came back for minor gains among steels, motors, merchandising and rails then settled down for a do-nothing performance during the remainder of the session.
The Associated Press average of 60 issues was off 1 of a point at 50.2. Transfers totalled 612,150 shares against 567,100 the day before.

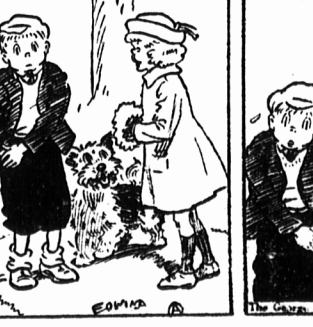

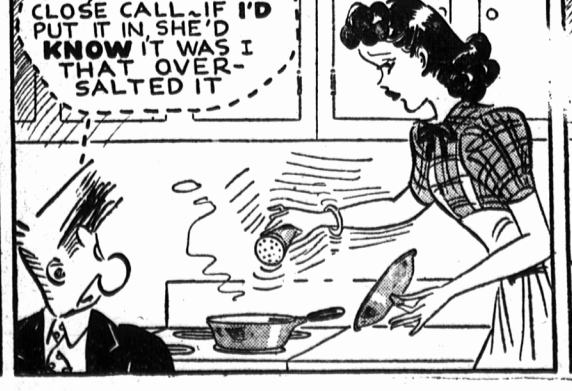
