### France Worried As Youth Heads To Grim Strife

PARIS, June 13 (CP)—A warning that French children are growing up in a civil war atmosphere is being sounded throughout France by political and educational authorities.

Infants lifting chubby hands in the clenched fist of communism or the stiff arm fascism—children joining rival political bands—youths shouting "La Roquette to the gallows" and "death to Blum" are cited as tending to put future Frenchmen against one another.

These warnings have, come in for grave discussion in the press, in public meetings and in government councils since eight-year-old Paul Gignoux was stoned to death April 25 at Lyon by other children.

The fact that the boy's parents belonged to Col. Francois de la Rocque's Nationalist French Social Party and his uncle was president of the Lyon Chamber of Commerce aroused reports his playmates killed him as a "fascist."

An official inquiry established that the boy, wearing his best Sunday suit and riding his bicycle, was called "girl in pants" by urchins who derided his fine clothes and long hair. When Paul answered their taunts, they threw a barrage of stones that broke his skull. Eleven boys were placed under public welfare supervision.

Though this incident turned out to be a boyish but tragic dispute, it became the inspiration for a campaign against violence and divisions among the young. "This tragedy worries us because it is only too symbolic," formed premier Edouard Herriot, president of the National Chamber of Deputies and mayor of Lyon, told his city council.

"Children are surrounded now by an extremely grave moral atmosphere. By pictures, stories, books and movies, they are brought to know the criminal actions. Our children come to consider violence as customary. They do not know the other side of the story, pitiless punishment."

A country which would tolerate such incidents to justice and to reason would fall into decadence. For my part, I will not tolerate them."

how/er, are deeply entrenched and will not be rooted out easily. The communist party presides over a particularly powerful youth movement. The Federation des Jeunes Communistes, headed by Secretary-General Leonce Granjon, numbers 2,000 members, at demonstrations demanding such things as "guns for republican Spain."

The communists also sponsor the Union des Jeunes Filles de France, already numbering 10,000 girls. Singing of the Internationale, waving of red flags and shouts of "down with fascism" marked their first congress. The Socialist Party controls a youth movement of 40,000 boys, often appearing in unofficial uniforms of red shirts and blue ties.

The radical youths form one of the most moderate wings of the Radical-Socialist Party. They have the crossed arms salute, compromise between clenched fist and stiff arm.

La Rocque's Social party is noted for its smart E. V. P. (equipes volantes de propagande), squads of young men in cream-colored shirts standing guard, with arms folded on chests, before the Speaker's stand at party meetings. The Royalist Action Francaise had its henchmen of the King, once numbering 15,000 beret-wearing students and others. It was active during the hearing Leon Blum Feb. 13 1936, but it has remained active.

### Bermuda - New York Airways Route Ready

PORT WASHINGTON, N. Y. June 10—(CP)—A final survey flight to Bermuda and back, with 25 observers aboard, was completed today by the 21-ton flying boat Bermuda Clipper.

Regular passenger service between the United States and the mid-Atlantic British island is to be inaugurated Saturday.

The Clipper reached its Long Island terminal here at 5:07 P. M. ADT completing the 783-mile return flight in five hours, 40 minutes. It made the outward journey in five hours 22 minutes.

The Cavalier, the other of the two flying boats to be used in the service, is here being made ready by Imperial Airways for the inaugural flight to Hamilton harbor with company officials on Saturday.

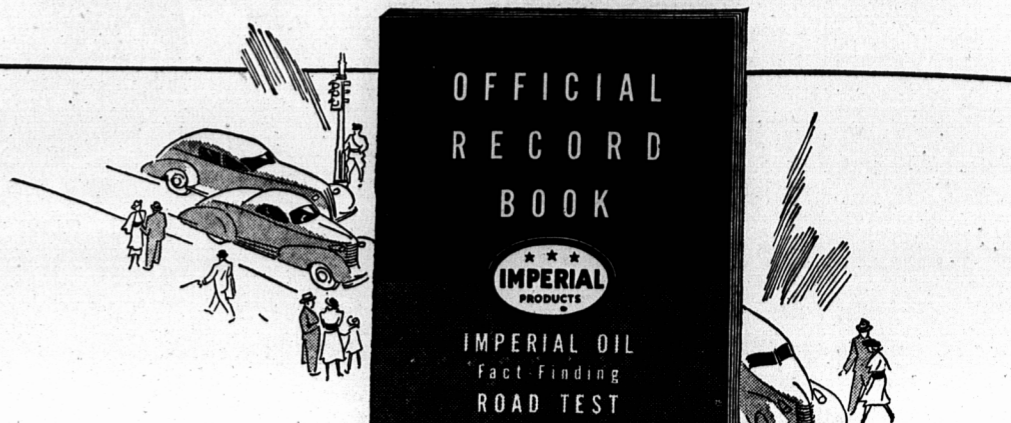
### SPRINGFIELD WOMEN'S INSTITUTE

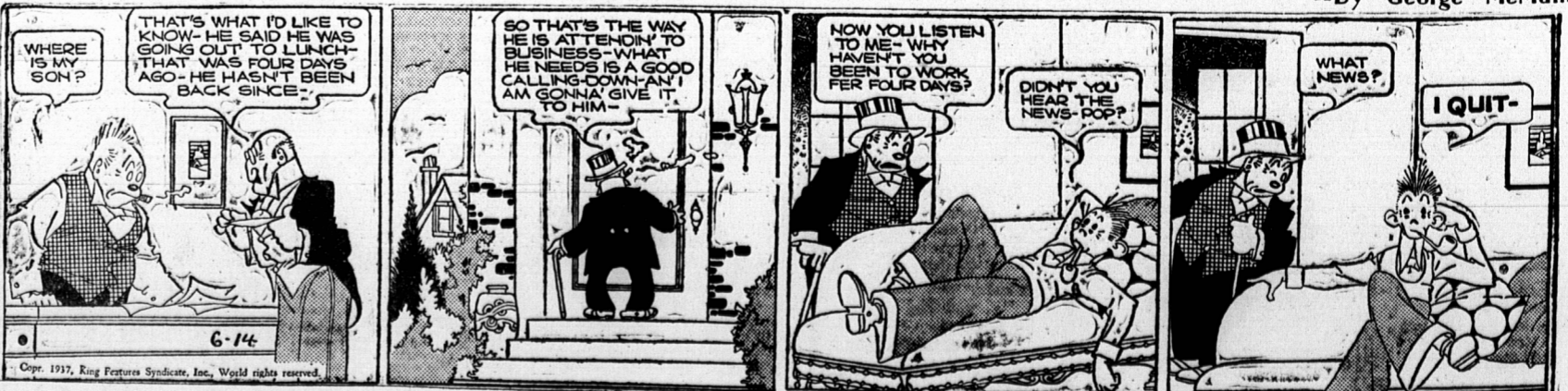
