MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING OF PRESBYTERY

Call From Alberton to Rev. Mr. Millar Accepted—Several Other Calls—Home Mission Committee Gives \$100 to Hospital.

At Charlottetown, and within Zion Church there on Thursday, January 3rd, 1907 and at 11 o'clock a. m. which time and place the Presbytery of Prince Edward Island met pursuant to adjournment and was constituted by the Moderator, Mr. John Murray, with whom were present Messrs T. F. Fullerton, R. G. Sinclair, G. E. Ross, H. Michael, S. D. McPhee, E. Smith, A. S. Stewart, W. A. McKay, D. McNeill, A. S. Stewart, T. C. James, D. McNeill, C. McKinnon, D. McLaren, John McDonald, D. McDonald, R. Mann, Hon. B. Rogers, A. N. McLeod, elders, and John Gillis, Gao. Millar, Gao. McLennan, corresponding members.

The clerk read a letter from Dr. McCurdy, Halifax stating that the Home Mission committee had agreed to make a grant of \$100 for Hospital work in Charlottetown. Mr. S. D. McPhee introduced that he moderated in a call at Valleyfield on the 11th day of December last, that the call came out unanimously in favor of Mr. A. S. Stewart, Strathalbyn, that it was signed by 232 communicants and 78 adherents, and accompanied by a guarantee of \$800 stipend with use of manse and glebe. On motion the conduct of the moderator was approved. Commissioners from Valleyfield, viz., Messrs Charles McKinnon and Angus McDonald were then heard.

The clerk stated that he had cited the session and congregation of Strathalbyn to appear for their interests at this meeting. On motion the action of the clerk was sustained. Messrs McDonald, Matheson, McLeod and D. McDonald represented Strathalbyn, and expressed their earnest desire to retain their pastor. It was moved by Mr. T. F. Fullerton, seconded by Mr. E. Smith, that the call be not sustained but an amendment was moved by Mr. Charles McKinnon, seconded by Mr. S. D. McPhee, that the call be sustained. After discussion a vote was taken. Six voted for the amendment and three for the motion. It was then moved by Mr. T. F. Fullerton, seconded by Mr. E. Smith, and carried that the call be sustained at a regular Gospel call and placed in the hands of Mr. Stewart. The moderator presented one call to Mr. Stewart which was accepted by him. On motion the translation was granted. It was decided that the ordination of Mr. Stewart, into Valleyfield take place on Tuesday, the 22nd day of January instant, at 10:30 o'clock a. m. the moderator of Presbytery to preside and induct, Mr. Geo. E. Ross to preach, Mr. S. D. McPhee to address the minister and Mr. H. Michael the people. Serving of the edict was left in the hands of the interim moderator.

Mr. T. F. Fullerton was appointed interim moderator of Strathalbyn session and instructed to declare the pulpit vacant as soon as possible after the translation takes effect. Mr. T. F. Fullerton stated that he moderated in a call at Brookfield on the 17th of December last, that the call came out heartily in favor of Mr. Geo. Miller, that it was signed by 100 members and 118 adherents, and accompanied by a guarantee of \$800 stipend with use of manse. The conduct of the moderator was approved. Commissioners from Brookfield, Messrs Campbell, Brown, McCallum, and McLeod were heard in support of the call, which on motion was sustained as a regular Gospel call. Mr. W. A. McKay intimated that he moderated in a call at Alberton on the 30th of December last, that the call came out harmoniously in favor of Mr. Geo. Millar, that it was signed by 163 communicants and 70 adherents and accompanied by a guarantee of \$800 stipend with use of manse and glebe. The action of the moderator was approved. Messrs Rogers and McNeill, commissioners from Alberton, spoke in support of the call, which on motion was sustained as a regular Gospel call.

Messrs Wm. Moffatt and A. Moffatt represented Cavendish and spoke in support of a call from that congregation to Mr. Geo. Millar, and sustained at a previous meeting of Presbytery. On motion said calls were placed in the hands of Mr. Millar and the one from Alberton accepted by him. It was decided that the induction of Mr. Millar take place at Alberton on Tuesday, the 15th day of January instant at 7:30 o'clock p. m. Mr. W. A. McKay to preside and induct, Mr. E. O. Strathie to preach, Mr. A. D. Sterling to address the people, and Mr. T. F. Fullerton the minister. Serving of the edict was left in the hands of the interim moderator.

Mr. S. D. McPhee stated that he moderated in a call at Caledonia on the 11th December last, that the call came out unanimously in favor of Mr. Geo. McLennan, that it was signed by 130 members and 100 adherents, and accompanied by a guarantee of \$700 stipend. The conduct of the moderator was approved. Commissioners from Caledonia, viz., Messrs. McDonald and McPherson were

heard in support of the call, which, on motion, was sustained as a regular Gospel call, placed in the hands of Mr. McLennan, and accepted by him. It was decided that application be made in behalf of the congregation of Caledonia for a grant of \$100 from the Augmentation Fund, so that the stipend may reach the new minimum of \$800.

It was agreed that Mr. McLennan's induction take place at Caledonia on Tuesday the 22nd day of January instant at 3 o'clock p. m. S. D. McPhee to preside and induct, Mr. A. S. Stewart to preach, Mr. R. G. Sinclair to address the minister and Mr. S. D. McPhee the people. Serving of the edict was left in the hands of the interim moderator. Presbytery then adjourned to meet at Alberton on Tuesday, 15th inst at 7:30 o'clock, p. m. of which public intimation was given, and this adjournment was closed with the benediction.
