AVIATION MEETINGS DO NOT PAY.

There is very great interest in the new art of flying, but the big meetings called in different parts of the world to give public competitions in aviation have rarely proved self-sustaining. This, too, notwithstanding that many of the handsome prizes given have been donated by wealthy individuals, corporations or newspapers.

At Rheims the loss was set down at \$100,000; at Nice \$110,000; at Blackpool \$75,000; at Bournemouth \$50,000; and the recent meeting at Lanark \$40,000. The meetings in the United States and at Montreal and Toronto in Canada were nearly all disappointing financially.

Then there is the fact that an aviation meeting does not lend itself like a horse race or a ball match to enclosed areas with the chance of big gate money.

But nothing can check the growing enthusiasm for flight. Despite the financial losses of the big contests and the death or disabling of a number of the bravest men who have soared aloft others are ready to make the venture. Men have flown more than a mile and a half in height and at mile-a-minute speed, but others are ambitious to fly faster and higher and further than any other has yet done.
