PRESERVE DON'T.

Don't make a mistake and wait until the special fruit is over, and then pay the highest prices for it.

Don't think over-ripe fruit makes good preserves or jellies.

Don't ever use anything but the best materials for good results.

Don't use what is called "A" or soft white sugar, or brown; use granulated white sugar for all preserves and jellies.

Don't use granulated sugar for spiced fruit; use light brown only.

Don't make spiced fruit too sweet; four pounds of light brown sugar to seven pounds of fruit is a good proportion.

Don't use an abundance of spices—too much makes it taste bitter.

Don't cover preserves or jellies while cooking; they are apt to boil over.

Don't use cold sugar for jellies; measure the strained fruit juice; to each pint allow one point of the best granulated sugar. Put it on a platter in the oven to heat and add it to the boiling liquid.

Don't put hot preserves in cold glasses or jars and not expect accidents; have the glasses or jars in scalding water, rinse well, then fill as quickly as possible.

Don't allow preserves to stand about after they are cold; put melted paraffin on cover with lids, wash off every trace of stickiness, and put in a cool, dark place for future use.

Don't cook preserves over a gas range without an asbestos mat.

Don't let them cook without stirring, even when the fire is slow—Winnipeg Telegram.

A UNIQUE BRIDGE.
How B. C. Indians Solved an Engineering Problem.

Some interesting examples of Indian ingenuity are afforded on the River Skeena, and its tributaries in North British Columbia. These waterways in the upper reaches flow swiftly and for the most part through deep ravines. As it is impossible for the Indians to cross them by means of canoes, they have resorted to bridging. Their bridges are interesting structures from the engineering point of view, inasmuch as the cantilever principle is adopted. A bridge of this design spans about 120 feet wide, and the height from the bridge to water level is about 80 feet. It is built of wooden logs, the legs of the structure being formed of single stout logs varying from 60 to 80 feet in length. The task of lowering them into position must have demanded considerable ingenuity on the part of the builders. They are buried about 10 feet at their lower ends and anchored by the superimposition of masses of large rocks rolled and carried to the site.

The longitudinal members of the shore spans are similarly buried in the ground and lashed to the ends of the log legs. These main members, corresponding to deck girders, are about 120 feet in length, and extend to the A members, superstructure being erected thereon. Elaborate cross bracing is resorted to in order to secure a greater strength. When the bridge was first erected the different members were simply secured together by the British willow twigs, but when the more substantial suspension bridge lower down the river, the Indians proceeded and followed the white man's observations with great interest. They observed how the thick wire cables were slung and anchored, and accordingly decided to introduce wire into their own structure. They procured their own structure. They introduced wherever they could, and introduced it in a most fantastical manner. Also, when the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway engineers commenced working on their line near by, the Indians procured odds and ends, such as bolts and spikes, from them for introduction and spikes, so that now it is a strange looking piece of work, though the fundamental cantilever lines are still distinct.—Toronto Star Weekly.
