TORONTO, May 29-(CP)-Moderate weakness dominated the stock market today and the close was down 19 to 46 for the two mining groups and the industrials. Western oils held about even with the previous close. Trading was dull throughout the session until the final half hour when heavy turnover in Ontario Nickel swelled volume to double that of the first four hours. Turnover was 137,000 shares against 115,000 in the previous session.
