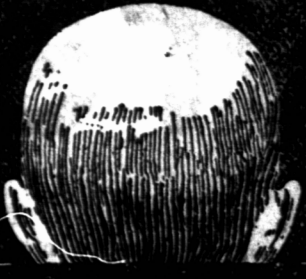

QUARTERLY CONFERENCE

Of the P. E. Island Baptist Association

Interesting Sessions Held at Summerside Resolutions of Regret at the Departure of Prominent Ministers.

The Quarterly Conference was held with the Summerside Baptist church last Monday and Tuesday. The first session was held on Monday evening when Rev. A. F. Browne of North River and Miss Martha Clark of Cavendish gave helpful and inspiring addresses. The first speaker dwelt upon the Home Mission needs while Miss Clark in a very helpful manner told about our responsibility for the heathen.

Tuesday morning and afternoon were devoted to business. As this was the annual meeting the officers for the ensuing year were appointed. Rev. A. H. Whitman of O'Leary, President and A. W. Sterns of Charlottetown, Secretary-Treasurer. The reports from the churches were favorable, several additions were reported and the spiritual tide rising. Regrets were expressed that some of the pastors were leaving the Island. Resolutions were passed expressing confidence in the character and abundant labors of Rev. H. Carter of Murray River and Rev. J. L. Miner of Charlottetown, who are about to leave for new fields of labor. Also a resolution of confidence in the aims and purposes of Bro. J. S. Clark of Bay View, who is going to enter upon missionary work in the Northwest among the Indians. Mr. Clark is a graduate of Acadia University and a young man of popular characteristics for missionary work.

After a consideration of some pastorless churches and how the needs of these fields could be met, the morning session closed.

This afternoon meeting was devoted to the consideration of the denominational work and the need of loyalty to our denominational institutions. A. W. Sterns of Charlottetown, Treasurer of Missionary Funds for the Province, gave an address using charts to illustrate the work being done. Mr. Sterns suggested many methods by which the offerings could be increased, urging the churches to improve their plans and push the work to a successful result.

Following this brief meeting the W. M. A. Societies had a meeting when Miss Martha Clark (returned missionary) gave a thrilling account of her work in India, urging the sisters at home to help more.

The evening meeting was devoted to a discussion on the subject of revivals. Rev. J. L. Miner spoke of the need of a general revival, Rev. C. P. Wilson of Cavendish, on the true revival, and Rev. A. H. Whitman of O'Leary, on the way this grand result may be attained. These addresses were strong and forcible.

After extending a vote of thanks to the entertaining church for the hospitality extended a very helpful conference closed.
