GIRL SINGER FOUND BOUND AND GAGGED.

PALMERSTONE, Ont., May 19.—The police tonight were still investigating the kidnapping and chloroforming, on Tuesday night, of Miss Edna K. Lee, leader of Knox church choir, and prominent musician, who was found gagged and bound in an out of the way part of the town yesterday morning.

Her parents and the police here attribute jealousy "and an attempt to blacken her character" as motives for the deed. Miss Lee is suffering from shock and exposure in the jail. Police Chief Wilson said today: "Miss Lee is a splendid singer and her leaving one church to go to another has caused bad feeling." The chief said he thought that an "organized grudge" might be at the bottom of the affair. The authorities are making investigations in Listowel, which is Miss Lee's home town, and in Guelph. The police say that Miss Lee not herself have tied the knot which bound her.

ISLAND TRAIN WAS DELAYED

MONCTON, May 20.—The train from Prince Edward Island, Cape Tormentine to Sackville, was delayed over two hours yesterday on account of a mishap in Cape Tormentine yard. While doing some shunting in the yard, previous to the leaving of the train which connects with No. 1 (Ocean Limited) at Sackville, a freight lost two or three cars which dropped down the incline and crashed into a coal car thus keeping the passenger train from leaving for two or three hours. The damage, which was but slight, was repaired early in the evening and the usual connection with No. 3 (Maritime Express) was made in the evening.

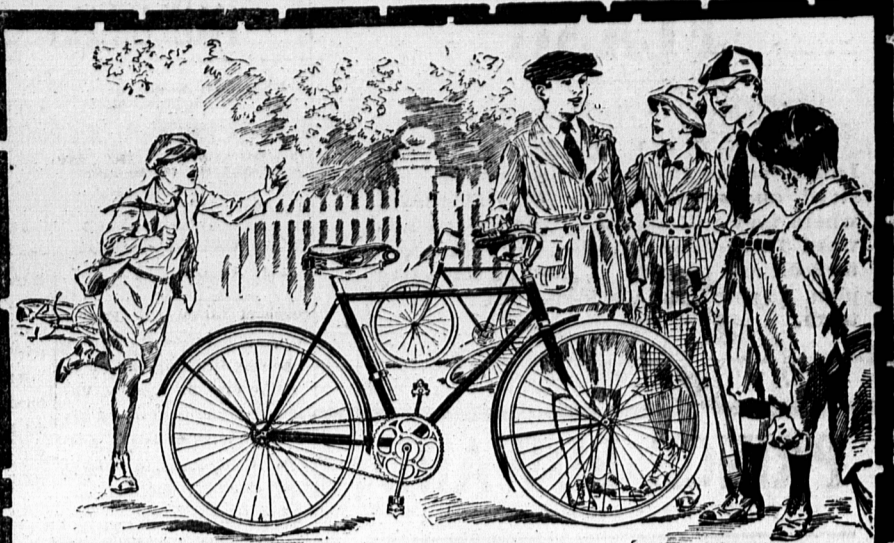
