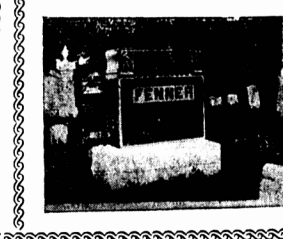

LAST RITES FOR D. A. NICHOLSON

Many friends gathered for the service held Friday afternoon at 2:30 at Not's Funeral Chapel for the late Daniel Arnold Nicholson of 20 Fourth St. S.E., who passed away at his home last Wednesday, July 21st. Rev. Ted E. Colley of the Alliance Tabernacle officiated, bringing a word of comfort to the bereaved from the Scriptures. Mr. Nicholson's favorite hymn, "Face to Face With Christ My Saviour" was sung as a duet by Mrs. A. Spine and Mrs. T. E. Coley. Rev. Jack Cousley, formerly of Medicine Hat, now a missionary for Bolivia South America, led in prayer. Mr. Melvin S. Yeo presided at the organ. The pallbearers were Messrs B. Sandberg, W. D. Fenton, A. Spine, A. Baille, H. Milten, D. Fleming. Interment was made in the family plot at Hillside cemetery. Mr. Nicholson who died at the age of 52, was born in Quincy, Mass. on March 27, 1894. He was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. John A. Nicholson, Wood Islands, P. E. Island. At the age of seven his parents took him to Prince Edward Island where he spent his early life and received his schooling. He came to Medicine Hat and entered the employ of the Canadian Pacific Railway and had been thus employed in Medicine Hat and neighboring divisions for the past 30 years. He was a conductor, and member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen. In 1919 he and Beryl Taylor were united in marriage.
