A new, modern bakery, which is to be the largest and most up to date in Canada, will be erected by Christie, Brown and Company, Limited, just west of Toronto in Etobicoke Township, Alex. A. Fraser, President of the Company, announced today.

"This expansion program is indicative of our faith in the unlimited business opportunities of the west and the fact that we look forward to Canada's future and can see its progress," Mr. Fraser said.

The very latest in automatic baking equipment will be installed and straight line production methods will be the outstanding feature. Electric tractors, using the floor skid system, will handle the flour, and the material will be straight through the bakery to the final operation where the biscuits fresh from the ovens will be sealed in their various containers. Much of the new equipment is being designed by the Company's Engineering Department. Particular attention will be paid to cleanliness and sanitation. All walls and partitions, walls and columns will be constructed of or faced with non-absorbent washable tile.

The building will consist of one high story with a mezzanine on which employee facilities will be located. These will include lockers, wash rooms, dressing rooms, showers, cafeteria and a medical centre with a first-aid room.

All of Christie, Brown's, scull manufacturing facilities for Eastern Canada will be concentrated in the new plant. What has been until the advent of the new plant in Etobicoke, the most modern biscuit bakery in Canada was opened by the Company in Waterloo, Ont., in 1922.

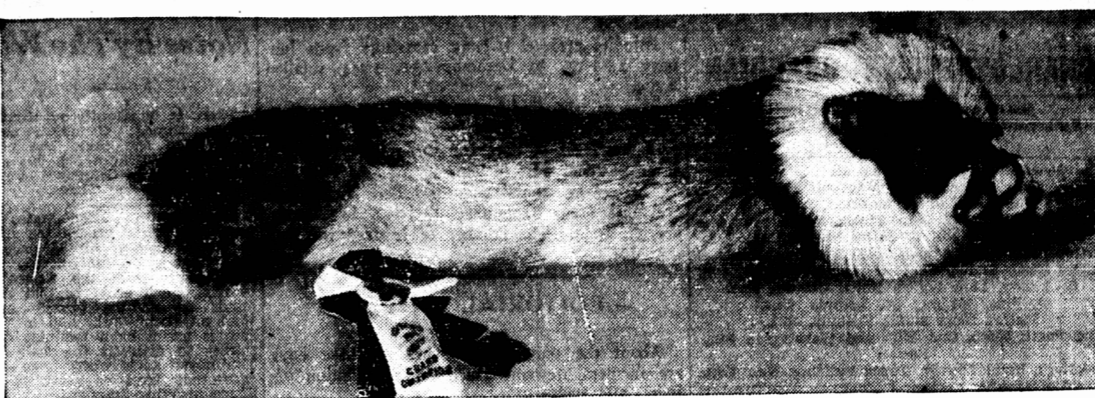

### Turgeon To Head Embassy In France

REGINA, Aug. 14 — (CP) — Hon. William F. A. Turgeon, K.C., Canadian ambassador to Belgium, has advised Prime Minister Mackenzie Bowden, that he has been offered the post of Canadian Ambassador to France.

Mr. Turgeon, Saskatchewan Attorney-General from 1907-1921, said he would accept the offer which was made by Prime Minister Mackenzie Bowden, now attending Paris peace conference.

He was appointed Canada's first Minister Plenipotentiary to Argentina in 1941 and served in that post until 1944 when he was named the Dominion's first minister to Mexico. His appointment as ambassador to Belgium was made more than a year ago.

A native of Bathurst, N.B., Mr. Turgeon received his early education in the United States and at Loyola University, Que. He became articled to a law firm in St. John and was admitted to the New Brunswick Bar in 1902.

Mr. Turgeon came west to Prince Albert, Sask., and together with the late Mr. Justice Lamont of the Supreme Court, practiced law. He was crown prosecutor at the age of 26 and served in that capacity until named attorney-general in 1907.

He was elevated to the Court of Appeal in 1921 and was made Chief Justice in 1936.

Mr. Turgeon is chancellor of Notre Dame College.
