Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, Jan. 14 — (AP) — Strong demand spun the usually lumpy May rye futures prices up to highs for the season in fairly steady trading today.

WINNIPEG, Jan. 14 — (CP) — Late selling wiped out most of the early gains in rye futures today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Early advances ranged as high as four cents a bushel. Traders responded to higher prices at Chicago and good buying here for American accounts. Later offerings came more liberal and values fell off.

TORONTO, Jan. 14 — (CP) — New high price levels were posted on the Toronto Stock Exchange today by all index groups. Volume at 3,832,000 shares was the heaviest since Nov. 19 last.

Trading interest was concerned chiefly with the cheaper golds. Marcus gold climbed to 2.20 and closed at 2.06 for a net gain of 70 cents while trading in heavy volume. Coin Lake touched a new high at 1.05 and closed at 91 for a net gain of 19 cents. It traded in volume of 115,000 shares.

MONTEREAL, Jan. 14 — (CP) — Buoyancy prevailed on average today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market as the busy and high-grade trading continued. In the indices, papers, industrials and metals rallied. New highs among the sub-divisions of issues boarded. Metals, refiners and beverages were strong spots. List of stocks appearing duplicated the all-time high set on Friday. Some of the leaders failed to hold at their best level for the day but finished ahead by a comfortable margin.

NEW YORK, Jan. 14 — (AP) — Late by steels, the Stock Market swept to a new 15-year high today in active dealings with gains from 1 to more than 3 points.

The pace was fast from the start. U. S. steel 20's, wholesale, closed this to better than 3 and finished with a net advance of 2 7/8. Common stock block up 2 3/8. Lukens Steel 3 1/8. Youngstown Sheet 1 5/8 and Republic Steel 1 1/4. Common stocks were up 1 1/2. Closing prices in most cases were under the best. The Associated Press high 4,000 composite was up 1 1/2 points at 79. Industrials made a high since 1935, the rally began in 1931 and the utilities since 1937.

JASPER, Alta. — Atomic energy will become the basic power of a new industrial era, said D.H. Massey, senior member of the British atomic research party that worked for two years on materials for the atomic bomb, when relaxing in Jasper National Park. Automobiles, airplanes and ocean vessels, operated by atomic power, would be nothing resembling those used today, he said.
