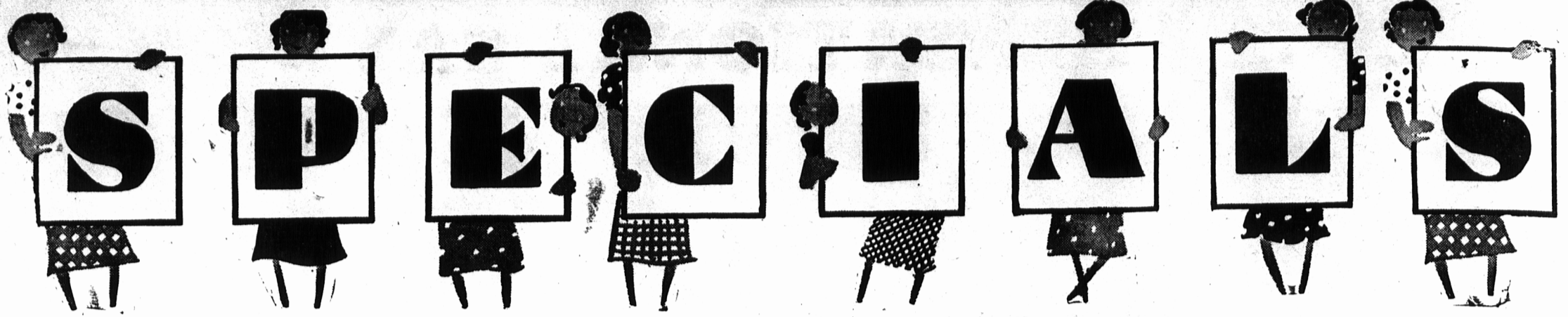

In Memoriam

MR. AENEAS McDONALD

A sad gloom was cast over Grand Tracadie and surrounding districts when it became known that Aeneas McDonald had passed to his eternal reward on the afternoon of October 14th. Aeneas was a man of splendid physique, strong and robust, of exemplary character, upright, honest, charitable ever ready to lend a helping hand, which qualities acquired for him the love and esteem of the neighborhood. Death came in his early manhood at the age of fifty-one years and when he knew that for him time was measured he willingly accepted God's decree. While life was sweet and ambition strong he turned away from the things of life and with resignation faced etern-

ity. It was hard to leave his dear ones but God willed it and with the faith that was his heritage from generations of Catholic ancestors he made his preparations, receiving the last rites of his church from his Pastor, Rev. K. MacPherson, who with two brothers of the deceased, Rev. William V. and Rev. Leonard frequently visited him during his illness. Though suffering for a long time from a fatal disease he was never heard to murmur but continued to work and care for those near and dear to him to within a comparatively short time of his death. The many spiritual bouquets, mass cards and letters of sympathy pay silent testimony to the esteem in which he was held. He leaves to mourn his loss a heart broken wife and two sons, John Lea age 10 years and Leonard aged 4 years also his aged mother, six brothers, Rev. William

V., Rev. Leonard, Joseph, Alban, Bernard and Louis and two sisters Annie and Mary E., Mrs. John McDonald, Bedford. His father predeceased him last December. The sympathy of the whole community goes out to the sorrowing widow and children bereft of the loving care and strength of a devoted husband and father. His funeral, held from his late residence to St. Michael's Church, Corran Bann on Monday, October 16th, was followed by a very large concourse of people. The funeral mass was celebrated by his brother Rev. Leonard McDonald assisted by Rev. William V. In the Sanctuary were Rev. K. MacPherson, Rev. Louis Dougan, Rev. George McDonald, Rev. Geo. McCormac, Rev. Louis Callaghan, Rev. Terence Campbell, Rev. J. C. McDonald and Rev. Joseph Rooney. The pall-bearers were his four

brothers, Joseph, Alban, Louis and Bernard, his brother-in-law John McDonald and cousin Kenneth McDonald. To those he leaves behind, his life will be a sweet memory and his death an inspiration and encouragement. May he rest in peace.
