# SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY person who has a claim in Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 16, not reserved to the head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section (1/4) acre, more or less.

Applications for entry must be made by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Sub-agency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may now be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader.

The homesteader is required to perform the following duties:

- (1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
- (2) A homesteader may, if he so desires, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint owner of such land will not meet this requirement.
- (3) If the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of the homesteader is a settler on a homestead of not less than eighty (80) acres, he or she may, if he or she so desires, perform the required residence duties by living with the father or mother.
- (4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than the miles in a direct line, a width of which is not more than 100 acres, in the measurement.
- (5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above provisions, must give notice in writing to the Agent for the District of the Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for a patent.

Deposits of the minister of the Interior, N. B. 1 - authorized by regulation of this act, the same will not be paid for.
