MONTREAL, April 3 —(AP)—The flow of international money ebbed away from the United States dollar in today's foreign exchange dealings as Prime Minister Chamberlain invited all nations to share in an anti-aggressor movement. The Pound Sterling advanced 1-4 cent to 4.68 3-8 and the French franc .00 1-4 of a cent to 2.65. The belga was up .02 of a cent, the gulder .04 of a cent and the Swiss franc .03 of a cent. Canadian funds were at a discount of 27-64.

MONTREAL, April 3 —(CP)—Receipts on Montreal livestock markets today follow: Cattle 707; calves 574; hogs 588; sheep and lambs 66. Cattle were steady and calves firm to 25 cents higher. Hogs were lower with no early sales. Good steers made from \$7 to \$7.50. There were no real tops. Medium steers were \$6 to \$7 and common from \$4.50 to \$6. Heifers ranged from \$4 to \$6.75 with an odd top at \$7. The odd fed calf or baby beef brought \$8. Good cows were mostly \$5.25 to \$5.50 with medium from \$4.25 to \$5 and common from \$3.50 to \$4. Canners and cutters made \$2.50 to \$3.50. The markets will be closed on Good Friday April 7. There was a light offering of calves. Prices were steady to 25 cents higher. One good calf was sold at \$7 with medium kinds around \$6 and fair to medium from \$5.00 to \$5.75. Common to just plain quality made \$5 to \$6.25. Common thin light yearlings sold down to \$4.50.
