

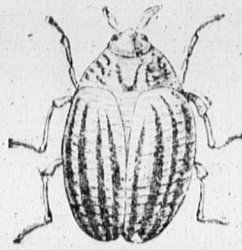

IS MUCH ALIVE.

LONDON, June 25.—An unfounded report having been circulated throughout Britain and called to other portions of the empire that Harry Furniss, the celebrated artist of Punch, was dead, Mr Furniss corrects the story in the following characteristic letter to the Times:—
"Sir—As I am receiving telegrams, letters, applications for photographs, and other obituary compliments too numerous and depressing to deal with, will you kindly allow me to assure my friends and enemies—including the Chancellor of the Exchequer—that I am very much alive and hard at work.
The artist who has just passed a way and I unfortunately for me and perhaps for him have been all our lives mixed up through similarity of name. He and I never met and were in no way related. His name was Harold Furniss; and although I have been compelled ever and over again to disclaim any connection with my name double, and have tried to live the misrepresentation down, my persecutors have killed me at last. Yours truly, Harry Furniss."

THREATENS GREECE.

BUCHAREST, Roumania, June 23. The Roumanian Foreign Office has made a peremptory demand upon the Greek Government for satisfaction for the injury suffered when a motor at Piraeus recently attacked a Roumanian mail steamer. Greece is given eight days in which to comply with the demand, after which Roumania will take the steps necessary to uphold the national dignity." The satisfaction is to include official apologies, material compensation for the damage done, and the dismissal of the prefect of the port of Piraeus.

SPAIN AND THE VATICAN.

MADRID, June 23.—It is believed that a rupture is imminent in the negotiations between the Government and the Vatican on the subject of the Church and non-Catholic religious societies. Premier Canalejas has received by telegraph a summary of the Vatican's reply to his proposals, and he has had a conference with the King to discuss further action. It is understood that the Vatican's reply is unsatisfactory.

A semi-official note recently issued intimated that if the Vatican insisted on coupling its protest against the royal decree of June 11 with the negotiations to revise the Concordat, the Government would be obliged to break off all negotiations.

Prior to the issuance of this note, the Premier declared in the Chamber of Deputies that the Government was resolved to live up to the legislation on the standpoint of reform.

At a meeting of Catholic defence societies, it was announced that before the policies outlined in the speech from the throne were permitted to become law, Spain would have to undergo a perilous crisis, as Catholics preferred civil war to the late school system.

A Clerical situation is growing in Barcelona and Seville, while the Clerical party in Madrid has begun a strong campaign against the ministry.

GIVEN HONORARY DEGREES.

OTTAWA, June 25.—Messrs Anthony McGill, analyst of the Department of Inland Revenue, and Roy Canon Chouquette, of St. Hyacinthe, were tendered honorary degrees of L. L. D., at the Ottawa University closing exercises today. The rector, Rev. Father Murphy, and others gave addresses, and a long list of diplomas were announced.

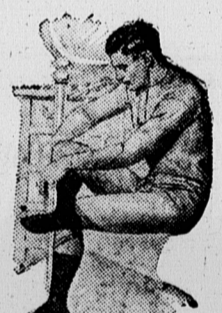
