Carlton, an elderly and much respected lady passed to her eternal rest, at the matured age of 89 years. The late Mrs. Carlton was not an ordinary person, but a lady of great force of character—a bulwark of strength to her late husband and family—ever ready to aid and counsel those in need—a firm supporter of the Methodist Church of which she was a constant member, generous to a fault but quick to administer reproof to the wrong-doer. Her husband the late C. C. Carlton died some 20 years ago. There were born to them two sons and two daughters, Caleb the eldest lives in the old homestead and continues the business conducted by his father, Susan (Mrs. Wm. Mellet,) died over 20 years ago, Alfred the second son was drowned at sea and the youngest daughter Miss M. J. Carlton, who faithfully attended her mother to the last at home. Susie the infant child left by Mrs. Mellet at her death was adopted by her uncle Caleb and is an official in the Canadian Bank of Commerce. Mrs. Carlton's family name was Spencer, whose family formerly resided near Charlottetown, and of whom she was the last survivor.—S.
