## PRODUCE

(Canadian Press)  
MONTREAL, June 7—Prices generally steady on the Montreal produce and dairy market today. Eggs eased slightly while cheese butter and potatoes held firm.  
Eggs declined a quarter of a cent a dozen, extra in cartons or less being quoted at 10 1/2 cents, firsts at 14 1/2 cents and seconds at 12 1/2 cents. Receipts were 1,824 cases.  
Cheese continued to sell at 10 1/2 to 10 3/4 cents a pound for current Ontario colored in cartons or less. At the weekly board of trade auction, 122 boxes of no 1 Quebec cheese sold at 10 cents a pound and 21 boxes of no 2 at 9 cents. Receipts were 555 boxes.  
No 1 regraded butter in cartons or less was unchanged at 17 1/2 to 18 cents a pound. No sales were made at the auction although 1,025 boxes were offered. Arrivals totalled 414 boxes.  
New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island green mountain potatoes were unchanged at \$1.00 to \$1.10 per 90 pound bag but gained five cents at 30 to 35 cents for 80 pound bags.

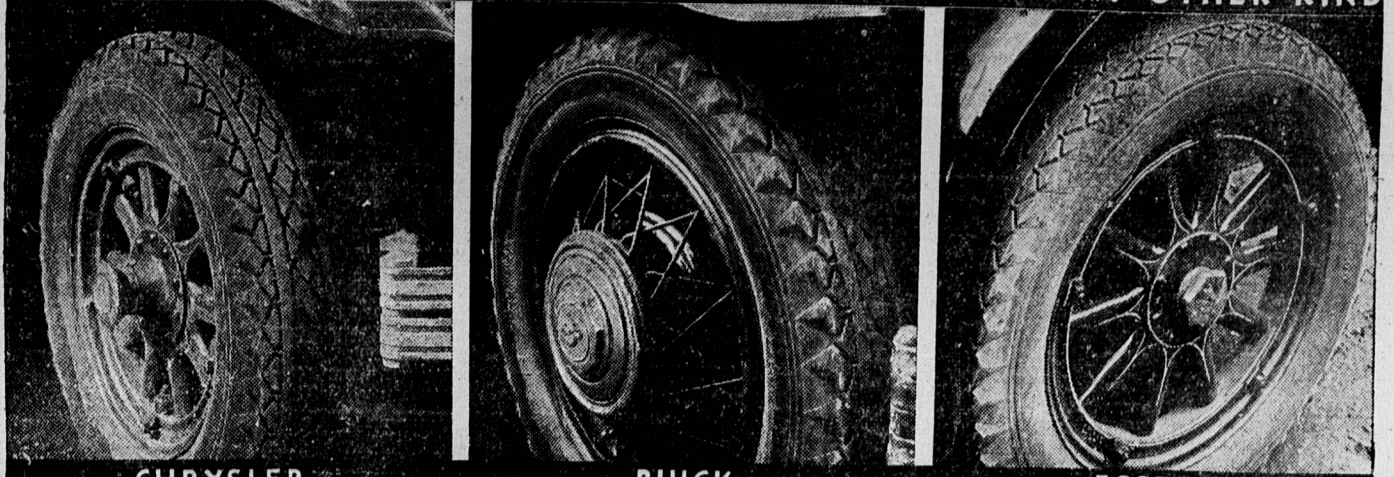

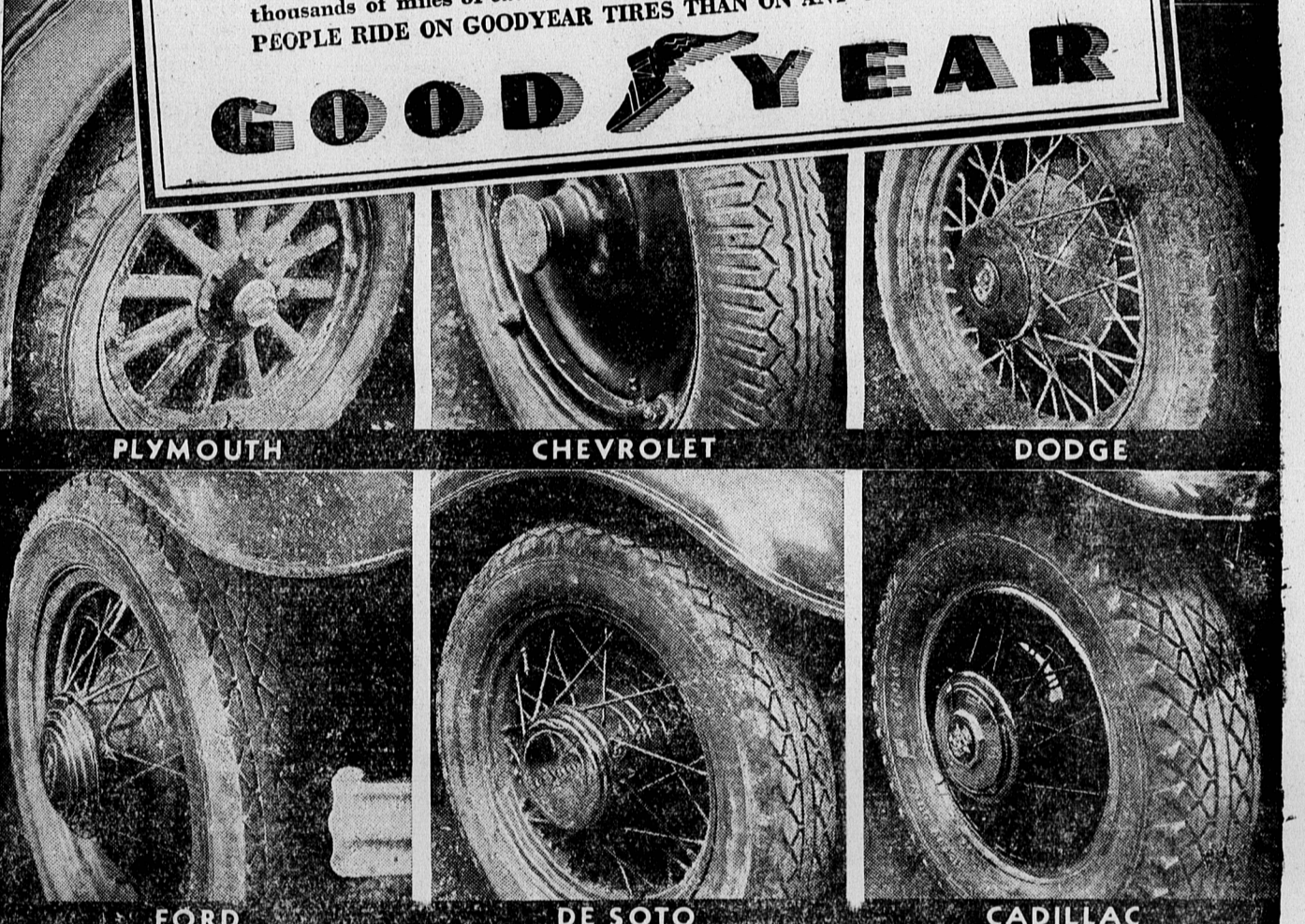

## CANADIAN DOLLAR AT NEW HIGH

NEW YORK, June 7—(C.P.)—British currencies were buoyant on the New York Foreign Exchange market today as the United States dollar took a sharp dip.  
The Canadian dollar touched its highest point in a year at 91 1-4 cents, up 7-16 of a cent. The pound sterling soared to its highest level since the United Kingdom suspended the gold standard in 1931. The pound closed at its top for the day at \$3.08 1-2, up 3-4 cents.  
Corresponding gains were recorded by Japanese yen and the European gold currencies. Bankers ascribed the American dollar's weakness to heavy buying by the United States of wool and other commodities in Europe. Another influence was the widely current report that an open market for trading in gold is soon to be established in New York by the Fed-

## LONDON MARKET

LONDON, June 7—(A.P.)—The United States dollar, swayed principally by movements in New York, lost four cents in moderate trading today.  
The rate was marked to the New York level at the opening—\$4.04 1-4 to the pound—and scarcely moved until half an hour before the bank closing when it depreciated to \$4.05 7-8. Offerings exceeded light buying orders. The close yesterday was \$4.01 7-8.  
Heavy buying of several specialties, mostly low-priced issues, and strong support for metal company equities, provided features in the day's active market. The bond market reached a new high for 1933.

## N. Y. Market Strong

NEW YORK, June 7—Stocks rallied strongly in some departments today, but were less aggressive in others. The balance of net changes, however, leaned substantially to the upside and the 90-share composite made another new high since November, 1931.
