Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, May 16 (AP) - Grain markets started on the off side today but after the first two hours made a quick recovery that sent May wheat within 3-8 of the futures ceiling and May rye to a 20-year high.

WINNIPEG, May 16 (CP) - Further sales of Canadian wheat in the form of flour to the United Kingdom were reported today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange with traders placing estimates at 2,000,000 bushels.

TORONTO, May 16 (CP) - The Toronto Stock Exchange is listing six new mining stocks and they will be called for trading on Friday, May 18. The new listings are Bonville Gold Mines Limited, Kayrand Mining and Development Company Limited, Marcus Gold Mines Limited, Nib Yellowknife Mines Limited, Yellowknife Mining Corporation and Yellowknife Mines Limited.

NEW YORK, May 16 (AP) - The Stock Market gathered a little momentum today after the two previous listless sessions and prices rose fractions to more than 2 points in a general advance paced by peace-rattled issues. These factors helped create buying demand for Westinghouse, which closed up 2. Johns-Manville climbed 3 7/8 on an announcement by directors increasing the dividend for the second quarter and Allied stores surged ahead 1 1/2 to a new high on a similar declaration. The Associated Press 60-stock composite gained 2 of a point at 64.

MONTREAL, May 16 (CP) - Mainly due to activity among junior stocks, the Montreal market advanced today. In other transactions, papers and utilities gave rising displays. Tops in turnover among junior mines were Central Cadillac, with 288,650 shares, and Anglo, with 168,020 and Nib Consolidated with 65,357. Each finished in higher ground. East Sullivan was a strong spot with a rise of 75 cents, and in gain territory all or most of the day were Perron, Pandora, Kirkland Gold, Carter Aumake, Donalds, Bouscadille, Shawkey, Siscoe and Wiltsey.

TORONTO, May 16 (CP) - Volume improved and prices advanced in the mining groups today on the Toronto Exchange while the Western Oils took a set-back of 33 in the index. Quomont was in the spotlight with an advance of 22 cents to a new high at 10 1/8 on volume of 26,000 shares. The company announces there is nothing new to report about drilling results on the property but the market for the stock has been strong and active through two sessions and the shares of companies near Quomont also were in demand today at rising prices. Oskio Lake, lying southeast of Quomont, traded 296,000 shares and touched a new high price of 1.20. It closed at 98 for a net gain of 26 cents over its Tuesday's gain of about 15 cents. Baramac and Wiltsey-Coghlan, situated near Quomont, traded 300,000 shares and firmed 3 1/2 to 7 cents.
