OUR PART IN THE NEW WORLD ORDER

Canadian women, best as we are, sheltered as we are, have no right to be complacent over the plight of our sisters in any part of God's world. Greece is still in the most pitiable condition; the 2,000 tons of wheat sent each month from Canada and other countries has only been a drop in the bucket.

Peasants get by, but those in the cities were on the verge of starvation with the situation this winter similar to that of 1942, when as many as 2,000 persons perished daily. Mr. Starbuck's deputy Greek delegate to U.N.R.A. emphasized the danger to the whole future life of the Greek people by this grim comparison--"In 1939 the excess of births over deaths in Athens was 5,369; in 1942, deaths exceeded births by 20,531." In Athens alone in a period of two months in 1941, nine out of ten babies died at birth. However we are thankful to learn through a joint statement issued in Washington and London, on March 18th, that in addition to the known monthly allocation, 2,000 tons of rice are to be shipped during this year, and also that Sweden has recently given 2,000 tons of dried fish and 200 tons of dried milk. It was also admitted in the statement that the Swedish ship Haltern is now engaged under British flag conducting in transportation from Venice to Athens foodstuffs from German sources which the Germans have undertaken to deliver to Greece in compensation for Greek produce which they have consigned.

Belgium is almost as badly off as Greece because of food supplies being cut off by war. The average daily calorie ration dropped in 1942 to the appalling level of 866, even in the first great war it never fell below 2280. French food supplies are very low, the people getting a ration of only about 1150 calories daily, when for adequate nutrition in health, we are told that 2600 to 3000 calories are required for those doing light work, while persons performing hard labor require 5000 to 6000 daily.

If the democratic peoples of Europe perish, and the totalitarian groups alone have the health to reconstruct Europe whose will be the responsibility? Whose unyielding policy has prevented the saving of the children of the friends of democracy? Dr. Howard Kershner, representative, American Friends' Service Committee.)

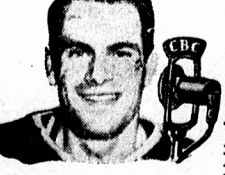
It would flee from the house.
 So there it was a few doors from the church, within a trim little bungalow, a bit of human tragedy darkening the lives of mother and children, all because a man was addicted to alcoholic beverages. My dad became a pauper because of poverty had to leave school and go to work at a tender age. All his life he felt the handicap of this and he could have provided a better home had he had better chance in his youth. So the iniquities of his grandfather were visited upon the children to use the third and fourth generation--Forward.
