Following a clean-up week in the town of Kensington this spring a property improvement competition sponsored by the Junior Chamber of Commerce began on May 15th and closed on August 15th.

Those receiving honorable mention for splendid improvement were Richard Inglis, Rebecca Champion and Ivan Darrach.

The competition was judged by Colonel Ernest Johnston and Ernest Dunning of Long River. Contesting properties were judged on the same point system used in the rural beautification program with emphasis on the amount of improvement shown.

Officials of the Chamber state that their work in promoting the competition was backed up from the beginning by the full cooperation of the Mayor and Town Council. New sidewalks were laid, crevices widened and handrails replaced and a number of other civic improvements done under the authority of the Council.

Citizens not entered in the contest, inspired by the spirit of cooperation and the results achieved by others made many improvements in their residences. At the opening of the competition pictures were taken by Mr. Dunning of the homes of those entering and at the conclusion further pictures were taken showing the wonderful improvement which is being achieved.

Organized in February with Mr. Theo Ling as president and Mr. E. D. Ashford as secretary it received its charter in May from the hands of the National President Mr. Philip Pugsley of Montreal.

As an outstanding example of the cooperation existing in the Chamber the members banded together this spring, selected a residence that Mr. Walter Thompson offered to paint it free of charge. Through the combined efforts of the members the job was completely finished, trimmings and all, in one hour.-S
