Tomato Chowder
Saute 2 tablespoons finely chopped celery and two tablespoons finely chopped onion in 4 tablespoons butter. When they are transparent but not brown add 2 medium sized tomatoes cut small and 2 tablespoons flour, and stir constantly until mixture is thick, when add 1 quart milk, slowly, salt to taste and add 1-4 teaspoon curry powder. Heat through and allow to remain in top of double boiler for at least ten minutes before serving. The curry

powder gives the elusive deliciousness to this soup.

Grapefruit Mint Cocktail

Cut grapefruits in halves crosswise, allowing one half for each person to be served, and remove seeds and membrane. Sprinkle pulp of each with 1 cream peppermint broken in small pieces, and chill. Garnish with mint leaves and serve on green glass plates if possible. If Roast Turkey is the choice try with it

Giblet and Onion Gravy

One half pound small onions, minced cooked giblets, 8 tablespoons turkey fat, 8 tablespoons flour, water, salt, pepper. Peel and cook the onions. Remove the turkey from the roasting pan, and measure the specified amount of fat from the pan. Add the flour to it and stir until very smooth and golden brown in color. Then add gradually the onion liquor and enough water to make four cups altogether, stirring constantly. When smooth and thickened, add salt, pepper, cooked onions and chopped giblets.

If it is a Baked Ham, or Loaf of Pork, do not forget to stick it generously with whole cloves, and you will find it a delicious change to serve it with.
