"I came to satisfy myself about you," Gabriel replied. "Now may I ask why you are here?"

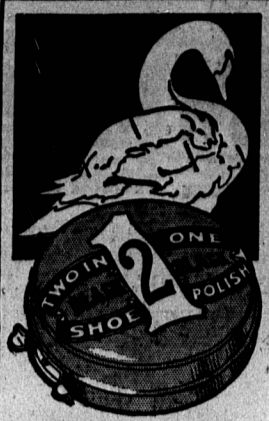
"I am here as a prisoner," Grenfall said boldly.

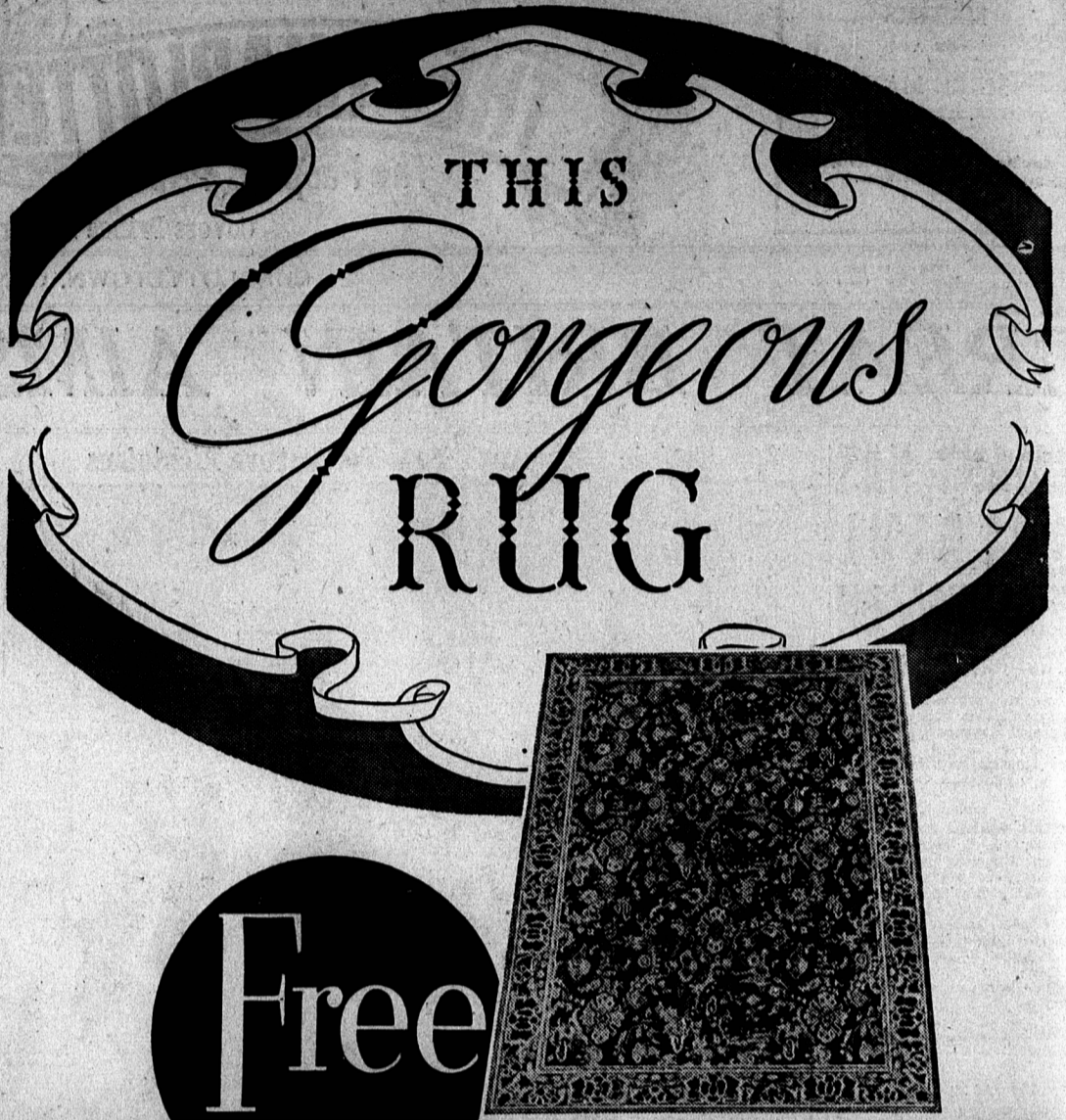
