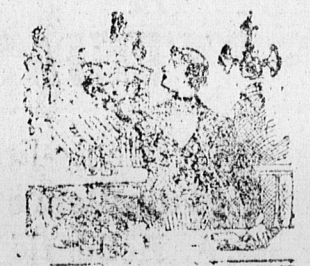

BUSINESS SLANDERS.

Shakespeare has said of slander in the social sphere that its tongue is sharper than the sword, that it outrenowns all the worms of Nile, that its breath rides on the passing winds and doth belie all corners of the world.

It is true that few are so audacious as to slander an honest business man openly with the purpose of injuring his business or prospects by specific false charges, although this is sometimes done and we believe has been done in our own city in recent times.

It seems therefore timely to call public attention to this evil, that the unthinking ones may be led to think of their ways and amend them, and that the malicious ones may have set before them a wholesome fear of the punishment which the law provides for their offences.

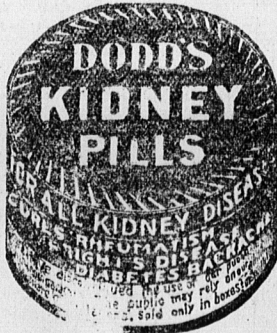

He had wide knowledge of public affairs, and in all the public trusts he held his intercourse with the public was characterized by affability, kindness and friendliness.

COUNTRY POSTMASTERS.

The keepers of the rural post offices have long done more work in proportion to their pay than any other class of Government employees. They rightly asked for more pay and were promised it months ago. The increase did not come and the postmasters were naturally impatient and the more so because the department was earning a big annual surplus.

Now an Ottawa dispatch tells that the increase has taken effect. The minimum salary of \$25 is increased to \$30 per annum. And they are to get in addition 50 per cent of the receipts of the office up to \$1000. The "forward" allowances at offices where mails are made up for other offices is also increased from ten per cent where the forwarding was direct and 5 per cent where it was indirect to 12 1/2 per cent of the revenue of the office where the forwarding is done, whether the service is direct or indirect. The increase of pay is not large, but it will be welcome as far as it goes.



The Conservative electors of Cardigan District in convention on Saturday last nominated W. A. O. Morson, K. C. for Assemblyman, and John A. McDonald for Councillor.

It now transpires that some symptoms of weakness had developed in the Quebec bridge before its fall, and that Theodore Cooper, the consulting engineer in New York, wired to Quebec to have the work stopped. The alleged likeness is by no means flattering to the senior Member for Queens and we warn the Star that he may resent it.
