Freak of Memory

(By Dominion News Service.)

LONDON, August 28.—The combination of a blow on the head and the fact that he "had more beer than was good for him," was responsible for a peculiar freak of memory in respect of John Paddock, aged 65, blacksmith, of Gordon street, Wolverhampton, who died from a fractured skull. At the inquest on Saturday a verdict of "accidental death" was returned.

Paddock was at the stable of Alfred Corns, and was warned not to go near one of three horses in the stable. He was seen, however, to "rush" at the horse's belly head first and rebound against

the side of the stall, and repeated this when he got up again.

Mr. Corns said deceased was kicked by the animal, but when being pulled from beneath the horse, one kick from the plunging animal narrowly missed his face.

It was after this that the deceased went to a house where he had lived fifteen years before, and insisted that he still resided there. After explanations, he was allowed to lie down on a couch, and was subsequently taken home.
