THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions.

ISLAND SOLDIER HEARD FROM

Mrs. Win. H. MacEwen, New Dominion, has received the following letter: "Dear mother:—I have arrived in England wounded. No doubt before now you have been officially notified. I was hit by a machine gun bullet in the inner part of the leg, near the thigh. Not too bad, might have been worse. The bullet went right through and did not hit the bone—a clean wound. It would make a long story to write our doings of late. I am put off reach of the censor. We left the Ypres salient in August, went back for a rest, but did lots of drill. We went by train part of the way to the Somme, then did four days' route marching, then slept out two days. We went into action in the 'Great Rush' on the 15 and 16. Our brigade was successful on the 15, and had not many casualties. We went over the parapet, captured the German front line and quite a lot of prisoners, who seemed glad to be taken. Again on the evening of the 16th we went over, but were met by heavy machine gun fire. I did not get to the Hun trench, before I got it. I stayed in a shell hole till after dark and then made out. I was able to walk while the wound was fresh—it is always better to do so if you can. I must close for now, as I have no stamps and a lady visitor is going to mail it for me. (She is going.) Your loving son, JOHN. In the Field, Sept. 18, 1916. Mr. MacEwen, New Dominion, P. E. I. Dear Sir:—I regret to inform you that your son, J. C. MacEwen was wounded in action on the afternoon of the 16th Sept. His wound is not at all dangerous, and he should be all right in a short time. I am extremely sorry to lose your son, as he was a very reliable man and always did his duty like a soldier and a man. Very truly yours, F. G. WOODS, Lieut., O. C. Scouts.
