The disappearance of snow from the roads will give a considerable impetus to the sales of the various motor companies. Ford of Canada is largely owned by small shareholders in this country and as a result interest in Canada in the motor industry centres largely around Ford of Canada. Dividends on this stock has been delayed for some particular reason—possibly to the fact that the tie-up of the Western wheat crop has made conditions in Western Canada somewhat unsettled and the management may be awaiting the outcome of the wheat tangle before dividends are inaugurated.

The opening of navigation, of course, means busy times for Canada Steamship Lines. This is another company that has suffered from the gigantic speculation of the Canadian Wheat Pool. There is a good possibility of this wheat beginning to move in the Spring and it stands to reason that the Canada Steamship Lines will experience a busy spring season. Even with the unfavourable conditions that existed late last year, the President stated officially that there was no danger of the preferred dividend being passed. The company is looking forward to another record year in the passenger and hotel departments and barring unforeseen conditions it can be stated that the outlook for 1930 is more encouraging than was the case last year.

The coming of spring sees thousands of new cars on the road as well as the return of hundreds of thousands that have been put in dead storage throughout the winter. The oil companies are the ones that benefit immediately from this, and from early spring until late in the fall operate at "full steam." There are many of these companies listed on the Canadian Stock Exchanges, but the leaders in the field include Imperial Oil, B. A. Oil and McColl-Frontenac.
