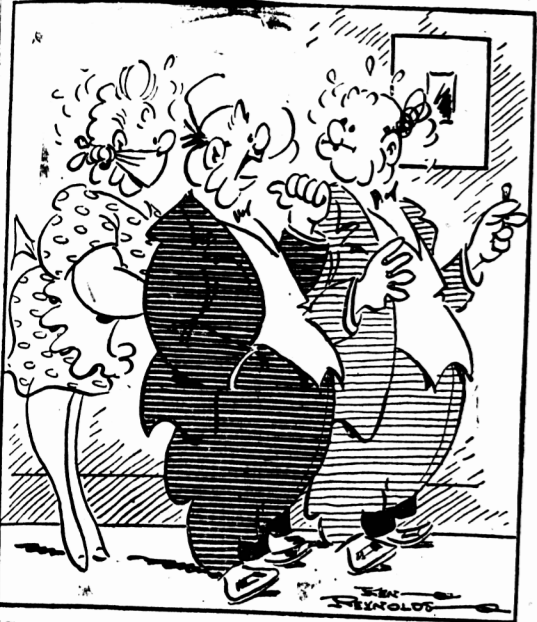

Contract Bridge

A Dangerous Practice
 Many players—even some highly rated players—makes a habit of opening the bidding with three diamonds or three clubs on almost any type of long suit. That this practice does not always work out well is illustrated by the following actual case.

North dealer.
 Both sides vulnerable.

♠ 8 5
 ♥ Q 6 2

The opening:
 North East South West

Although South was well aware of his partner's bidding habits, he could not fairly be blamed for answering the three-diamond bid with three notrump. He realized that the contract might be anything but a laydown, but with the top spades, and a stopper in hearts and clubs if either suit was led up to the temptation to try for game was almost irresistible. West made a fortunate decision when he led the heart jack, keeping his club position to trap declarer's suppositious king. Dummy played low and East correctly signalled with the eight. Declarer won and led the diamond nine. When West's queen appeared, declarer ducked in dummy because that seemed the best chance of maintaining communications and later running the diamond suit. As the cards were divided, however, this play did him no good. West continued with the heart ten and dummy's queen was neatly trapped. East then had the inspiration to shift to the club jack, and before the defenders were through, they had collected five club tricks, three hearts and one diamond for the tiny penalty of 500 points.

Getting back to the bidding, it was (to repeat) tempting for South to try for three notrump, but North had it in him if any excuse for leaving in the three-notrump contract. At player who opens the bidding with three diamonds on a hand such as North's, and then passes to three notrump, is not playing bridge—he's merely indulging in a wild gamble. True if the partner holds precisely the right cards, the gamble may succeed, but the successful bridge player is not usually one who makes a practice of playing "long shots."
