DETERMINED SITUATION Canada And United States TO ACHIEVE 'APPALLING' SUCCESS SAYS COSGRAVE

Empress Of Britain Sails With British Delegation - Parting Messages From Baldwin And Thomas.

S. S. EMPRESS OF BRITAIN, at sea July 13—(By wireless to the Canadian Press)—"We will not think of failure—we will not talk of failure; the people want us to succeed and we intend not to deceive them," declared J. H. Thomas, the Secretary for Dominion Affairs in the British cabinet, as the British statesman bound for the Imperial Economic Conference at Ottawa delivered a parting message while the giant liner Empress of Britain drove on past the Needles, off the Isle of Wight, this afternoon.

Chancellor And Minister Report To Hindenburg

BERLIN, July 13—(A.P.)—Chancellor Franz von Papen and Baron Wilhelm von Gayl, Minister of Interior, left for Neudeck tonight to report to President Paul von Hindenburg on the Lausanne conference, at which a plan to scale down Germany's payments was reached, and the German internal situation.

Basilian Order Is Recognized

VATICAN CITY, July 13—The Basilian Fathers, an order established in 1617, finally was officially recognized by the Vatican today in a decision of the Congregation of Oriental Affairs rendered after a 50-year "good conduct" probation period imposed by Pope Leo XIII.

Killed In Crash

LYONS, France, July 13—(A.P.)—On the last lap of a 4,700 mile flight, Colonel Gillmeny was killed today in a crash on the way from Venice to Le Bourget. Commandant Goslin, his companion was fatally injured and died in a few minutes. They left Le Bourget on July 5 and flew to Bucharest, Warsaw, Istanbul and Lyons.

Reprisal Measure imposing New Duties On British Goods Will Be Introduced In The Dail On Thursday And Enacted Into Law.

Gold Recovered From Laurentic

BELFAST, July 13—Bar gold worth nearly \$100,000 was recovered today by the salvage ship Estoy from the wreck of the steamer which sank in 1916 while carrying millions in bullion to the United States.

Charges Made By Representative

WASHINGTON, July 13—(A.P.)—Charges of undue foreign influence on the United States' Merchant Marine were made today by Representative Laguardia, Republican, New York, before the opening session of a House of Representatives post office committee investigation into post office department finances.

Construction Of St. Lawrence Deep Waterway, As An Engineering Project, Will Be Second Only To The Panama Canal - More Than Five Million Horse Power Of Electrical Energy Will Be Made Available.

OTTAWA, July 13—(By the Canadian Press)—The St. Lawrence deep waterway-ship channel from the heart of the North American continent to the Atlantic Ocean—is to be constructed. Canada and the United States have concluded an outline of the necessary treaty; final terms have been settled; and the treaty is being prepared for signature at an early date.

Protest Against Uruguay And Argentina Sever Relations

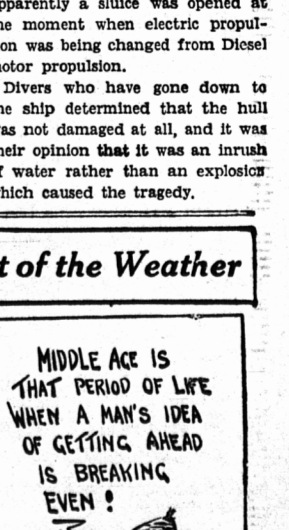
FRANCE AND BRITAIN SIGN ACCORD
