—TAKE UP RESIDENCE— Mr. and Mrs. Atwood Blakeney, Sea View, have taken up residence in Summerside for the winter months.

—INJURED IN FALL—Mr. John Arthur, Summerside, is confined to bed as the result of a fall which he suffered on Saturday morning while replacing some stowpiles at the Orange Hall. He was standing on a chair which was on a platform and in some manner the chair slipped from under him, causing him to fall heavily. While he is suffering some pain it is thought that there are no bones broken.

—ABEGWEIT PECEPTORY MEETING—The Royal Black Knights of the City of Summerside met on Sunday night in the hall of the Orange Room at Kingston, with Sir Knight T. J. Inman of Bedouque conferring nine degrees upon one Sir Knight, seven degrees upon seven Sir Knights and five degrees upon three other Sir Knights. Sir Knight Inman was assisted by other Sir Knights from Summerside and vicinity.

—LEAVE FOR U.S.—Mr. Sanford Phillips, president of West Point Perries Ltd. and other officials of the company and a competent engineer, plan to leave for the United States in the near future to endeavor to obtain a boat for the proposed service between West Point, P. E. I., and Buenos Aires. They will go first to Washington to contact the agency of the United States government which is similar to War Assets Ltd. in Canada and they will go wherever points are necessary to inspect available boats.

Seven hundred and fifty-eight more cars of potatoes were ferried from Borden to Tormentine last month than for the same month last year, according to figures recently released from the office of the superintendent of Canadian National Railways, Charlottetown. The figures for October, 1945, show 907 cars and for the same month last year 116 cars were sent across last month.

Turnips, however, showed a decrease of approximately 100 cars shipped as 162 cars went to the mainland in October of last year as compared to 26 last month. But livestock registered a gain of 27 cars since only 187 cars went to Tormentine in October, 1945, while 208 cars went across last month.

One car less of coal was imported to the Province via Tormentine last month compared to the corresponding period of 1945 for in October of that year 383 cars came across while 282 cars arrived at Borden last month.

The death occurred at the Prince Edward Island Hospital last Saturday night of Dr. J. Chester Houston, well-known Charlottetown physician. He was 72 years of age.

The late Dr. Houston was born in New Glasgow, P. E. I., and received his education at Prince of Wales College. He then entered McGill University as a medical student and graduated from that institution in 1908.

Following his graduation, the late Dr. Houston proceeded from Montreal to the United States, where he was successful in New Glasgow, Souris, Capraud, Kensington, before coming to Charlottetown. At the beginning of World War I, he offered his services to the Canadian Army Medical Corps and served with the front lines for the past twenty years or more, he had been chief anaesthetist and radiologist at the Prince Edward Island Hospital.

Following Mr. Hennessey's passing Mr. MacDonald operated very successfully the establishment until his sudden death yesterday morning.
