Buyer (to traveller)—No, no; nothing at all, thanks. We're overstocked now.

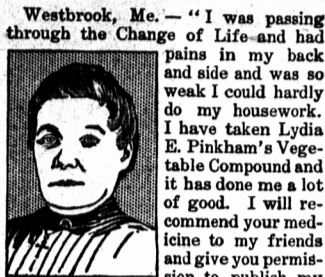

PORES SHOW IDENTITY

That your pores will tell you you are is the assertion of Dr. Edmond Locard, Director of the Police Laboratory at Lyons, France. Dr. Locard has been for many years employed as an expert to identify suspects and criminals by the finger print system, but he now identifies persons by examining enlarged photographs which show their pores clearly, says the Dayton, O., Journal.

Doctor Locard has found that in any individual the characteristics of the pores are always the same, but that in no two persons are they similar. The number of pores in a given area of skin remains the same throughout life. The number per square centimetre may be anywhere between nine and eighteen. The average pore is between eighty and two hundred and fifty thousandths of a millimetre in diameter, but in the individual it is invariable. Different persons have pores of different shapes, some irregular in shape, but only one is ever found in a person.

Pores are sometimes grouped so as to form the three corners of a triangle, sometimes as the four corners of a square and sometimes they are in a haphazard fashion, but every one has his own individual grouping. The distance between pores, though they differ in individuals, always average the same in the skin of any one person. Doctor Locard has found that the pores of women are further apart than those of men. Doctor Locard claims for his new method of identification the advantage over the finger print system that in the latter it is necessary to have an imprint showing a good part of a

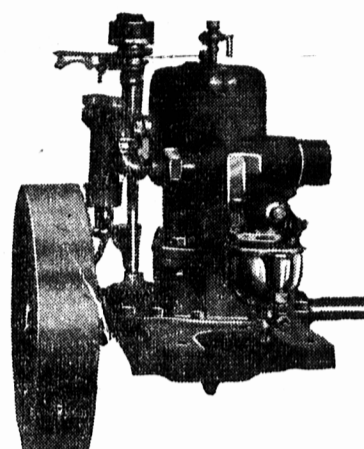
