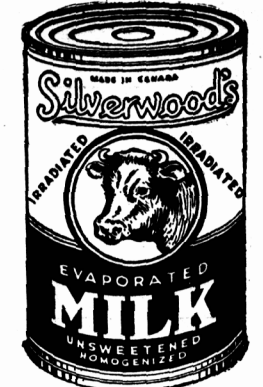

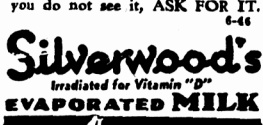
How Can I!
