Older Boys' Conference At O'Leary

The first of a series of three Older Boys' Conferences to be held in Prince Edward Island, opened in the United Church at O'Leary on Friday evening November 5th and lasted through until Sunday evening with almost fifty boys and parents present and participating in it.

The delegates were welcomed to O'Leary by Mr. A. J. Matheson in a brief address which was replied to by Wilfred Craig of Middleton. After a brief explanation of the conference arrangements and program the session closed with prayer and the delegates were shown to the homes where they were to be billeted.

The Saturday morning session opened at 9 o'clock instead of 9.30 in order that the work left over on Friday evening might be done. Rev. A. A. McLeod of Summerside led the opening service of worship following which the following Grand officers of the conference were elected: Grand Preter, Roscoe Walker, Kensington; Deputy Grand Preter, Jack Sheen, O'Leary; Grand Scribe, Bill Ross, North Belvedere; Grand Comptor, Ivan Darrach, Kensington. The next matter dealt with was a discussion on "The Revised Taxis Program" led by Rev. Mr. Milligan one of the conference leaders, during which the changes made this year and the reasons for them were discussed. The principal change is in the inclusion in a more concrete way of a boys relationships particularly in the home, at school or work, in the church and in the community, and the attempt to make the change through which the four-square boys, development, intellectually, physically, devotionally and socially, will render Christian service. This discussion was followed by a very interesting address on "The Boy and His Education" by Rev. J. M. Hooker of Summerside.
