IN MEMORIAM

MR. DANIEL F. McDONALD.

On Saturday afternoon we learned with sincere regret of the death of Mr. Daniel F. McDonald, of Vernon Bridge, senior member of the firm of D. & W. McDonald, of that place.

Mr. McDonald was attending to business as usual up till Thursday evening, when he was seized with a sudden attack of meningitis, and despite the best medical attention, passed away on Saturday afternoon.

Born at Tracadie, in 1852, he was in the 67th year of his age. His mercantile career began at the age of twelve, when he entered the employ of J. R. Bourke, shipbuilder and merchant of Mount Stewart.

Not only in his own locality, but throughout the province, will Mr. McDonald be remembered by the wide circle of friends which his integrity, kindness, and public spirit gained and held for him.

A consistent and devout member of the Roman Catholic church, he had many warm friends among those of other religious denominations. He was also a prominent member of the Knights of Columbus.

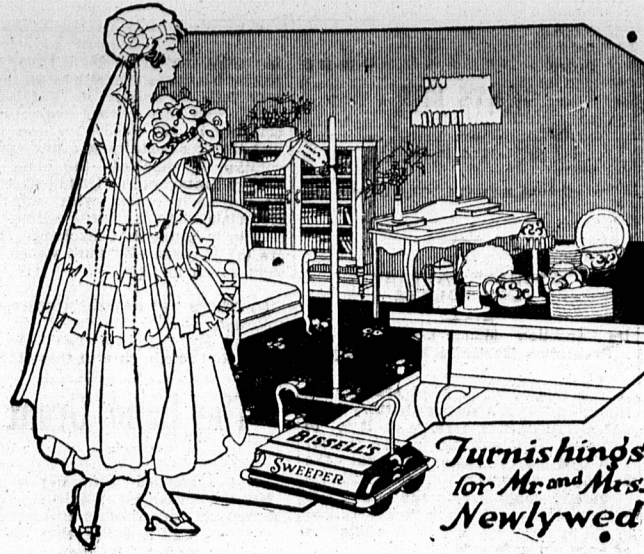

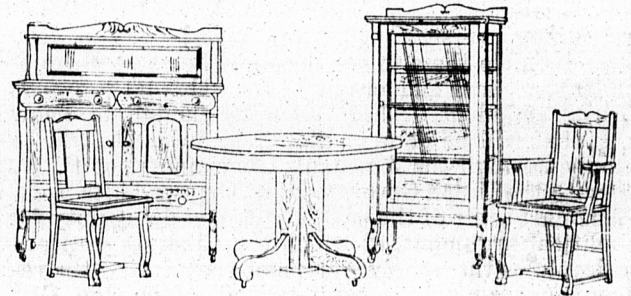
