TIME LOST IN TRAVELLING.

There is much to be desired in the matter of shortening the time of passage between this Province and Halifax. As everybody knows there are two routes, one very circuitous by way of Summerside, Point du Chene and Painesic, the other by way of Pictou which is much shorter—a comparatively straight line.

Returning from Halifax to Charlottetown the case stands thus: By the Point du Chene Summerside route the passengers leaves Halifax at 8.2 a. m., and reaches Charlottetown at 9 p. m. (?) being 12 hours and 40 minutes on the way. If he comes by way of Pictou he leaves Halifax at the early hour of 6.45 a. m. and reaches Charlottetown at 8.30 p. m. and is 13 hours and 45 minutes on the way.

FOR HONEST ELECTIONS.

The earnest men who compose the oral and Social Reform League are now giving attention to the question of pure elections. This action is timely. Corruption has crept in by degrees until it has become a national menace and a national disgrace.

The Reform League believes that our public men who are candidates in the election would much prefer to conduct the elections honestly and according to law. Elections conducted without the use of the corrupting agencies of money and whiskey would cost much less, they would be honest and would avoid the attestation in the courts and the danger of being unseated and disqualified.

What is proposed is that the candidates and their leading supporters all agree together and give mutual pledges that they will so far as they are concerned conduct the election according to law, avoiding any corrupt practices themselves, discountenancing corrupt practices in others and doing their best efforts to bring to justice any one who violates the law.

We believe that like results are easily possible here. Our Province is the most sober, law-abiding and free from crime of any in the Dominion. It ought also to be the banner Province for pure elections. It should be the highest object of every Christian, of every public man, of every true Islander to make it so.

Wherefore let every good citizen and every candidate give hearty support to the earnest efforts of the Reform League. Let corruption in every form be scorned and discredited. Let us all vote as honest independent freemen, and then when the votes are counted the honest verdict of the country will be recorded. This is of vastly more consequence than the success of any party.

The Exhibition opens tomorrow. Newfoundland like Canada is about to have a general election, with polling on November 2.

It is highly creditable to the four candidates for Queens that they have not only signed the pledge to conduct the elections, but that at least two of their number are giving liberal subscriptions for the purpose of preventing bribery and securing the observance of the law.

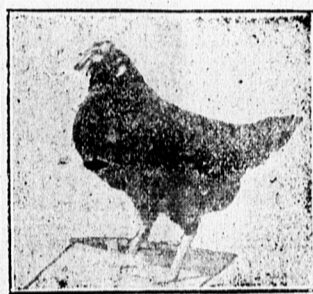

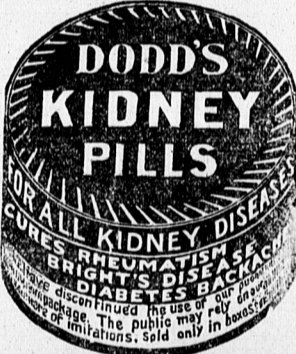
