

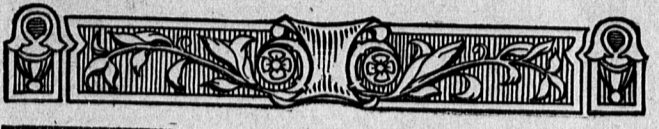

YOUNG WIFE DROWNED IN RIVER AT CHIPMAN Chipman, Dec. 11.—While skating down the river with her husband on Sunday afternoon, the young wife of Mr. Chipman, Mrs. Austin, the nineteen-year-old wife of Bert Austin, of Chipman, was drowned about a mile below Chipman when the thin ice gave away and both fell into the water. Mr. Austin managed to extricate himself with difficulty, his many efforts to gain a footing on the ice being frustrated by it breaking off. After sinking, Mrs. Austin never came up again.

The sad news of the fatality spread rapidly and many people started at once to search for the body. It was recovered in about two hours and was taken to the home of Fred Austin at Chipman, father of the bereaved husband.

The circumstances of the case are very sad. Only a year ago Mrs. Austin was married at Chipman by Rev. Mr. Smith. Recently her sister became ill and she paid frequent visits to the home of her father, Joseph Lucas, at Iron Bound Cove, a few miles away, to see her. On Sunday, after having dinner, Mr. and Mrs. Austin decided to make a visit to see the sister, and they put on their skates to go down by the river. They had skated about a mile and were very close to the shore when the ice went through, and both went into the river.

Residents along the river, friends of Mr. Austin, were called after he got ashore in an exhausted condition. They started to work immediately and recovered the body of Mrs. Austin in eighteen feet of water after a few hours' search. It was taken to Chipman and at the home of the bereaved husband's father many sorrowing friends called to pay their last respects.

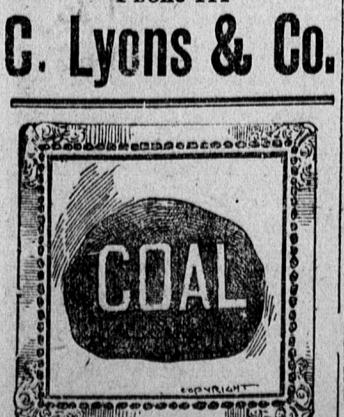
