INSPIRATION FROM CANADA.

From the turmoil and strife of our political squabbles we, in Canada, often turn with self pity towards the solid and stable governmental institutions of the mother land which we regard, and justly so, as the world's model in government.

It is refreshing to find that occasionally the mother land, looks to Canada for inspiration. Referring to the visit of the Canadian ministers at present in London The Standard of the 18th, July just received, has some remarks that are of peculiar interest and significance.

"Apart altogether from its specific objects," says the Standard, "the visit of Mr. Borden and his fellow ministers is of incalculable benefit to the British nation at the present juncture. We were in sad need of a tonic; and we have found the required stimulant in the presence of the Canadian statesmen, representing as they do with splendid adequacy the abounding vigor, the shrewd practical insight and the enlarged patriotism of a great young democracy."

THE PROHIBITION ACT.

During the past few weeks a large amount of correspondence, some for publication and some personal, has been received by the Guardian with reference to the enforcement of the Prohibition Act.

Our correspondents deal with conditions in their own localities and the information they give is valuable as showing how the law is being enforced. While we have no desire to place any restrictions on the manner in which such information is given we would prefer, and we believe much more good would be done, if the political aspect of the question were entirely eliminated.

The Guardian is not concerned, nor do we think the sincere friends of temperance are, as to whether one government does as well as or better than another. The thing is to have the Act enforced. In this government and government officials are powerless unless they receive the sympathy and support of the friends of temperance.

Judging by the vote which brought the Prohibition Act into existence the friends of temperance are an overwhelming majority in this province and if they are in earnest the Act will be enforced. We feel sure that neither the present government nor any other will knowingly run counter to the opinion of the majority, provided they know what that opinion is. The government has its officials appointed and we believe it is the intention of the government that these officials shall do their duty. It is for the people to give the officials what assistance they can, helping them and helping one another to see that the law is carried out; this failing, it will be the duty of the government to look to its officials.

Premier Mathieson has publicly, through the Guardian, expressed his intention to have the Act enforced and his intention has been quoted approvingly in many newspapers throughout the Dominion. The eyes of his own constituents and those of our sister provinces are upon him and we feel sure that he will see to it that his intention is carried out. Let the friends of law and order, irrespective of political partyism unite

small whip for the home land; "Six years of bitter and unfruitful party controversy," says The Standard, "have fatigued and enfeebled the nation's spirit. One party has been so busy in tearing down, the other so preoccupied in resisting plans of demolition, that the whole community has for the moment lost its sense of perspective. Unquestionably we are a more provincial people, with narrower instincts and a more restricted outlook, than we were at the beginning of the century."

And again this: "The masses have been debauched by a vast system of collective corruption and their patriotism has been undermined by constant appeals to the worst instincts of class, envy and cupidity." "At the Parliamentary Associations dinner Premier Borden is quoted as having read England a lesson with the remark that "a parliament elected chiefly on domestic issues, and so preoccupied with matters of purely domestic concern, can hardly be regarded as an Imperial Parliament in the highest and truest sense." which remark The Standard infers is "a subtle reproach to our absorption in parochial squabbles."

in this one aim that the country's law shall be respected and a few weeks or months at most will see a revolution in Prince Edward Island as far as the Prohibition Act is concerned.

It is regrettable to learn that the recent continuous rains, while much needed in some sections, did considerable damage in others. Hay cut immediately before the wet season set in and in coils has been completely ruined and will be fit only for the compost heap. In some parts of Prince County where the land is low the grain crops have been seriously damaged, and it is feared that the potato crop also will suffer. Prince Edward Island has seldom experienced such a long continued rainy season but in abnormal years even Prince Edward Island cannot be expected to escape.
