One of the principal motives underlying the merger is to organize the coal producing area of the Pittsburgh district so that a more economical operation of the mines may be coming a serious factor through improved safety rules imposed by Federal and State Governments and this can be cared for by a more uniform coal market. Outside of the concerns included in the proposed merger there remain only about 15 or 20 individual coal mining companies in the Pittsburgh coal seam as competitors, but the bulk of the production in the Pittsburgh district would be left practically in the hands of two great corporations, the Pittsburgh Coal Company and the proposed new organization.
