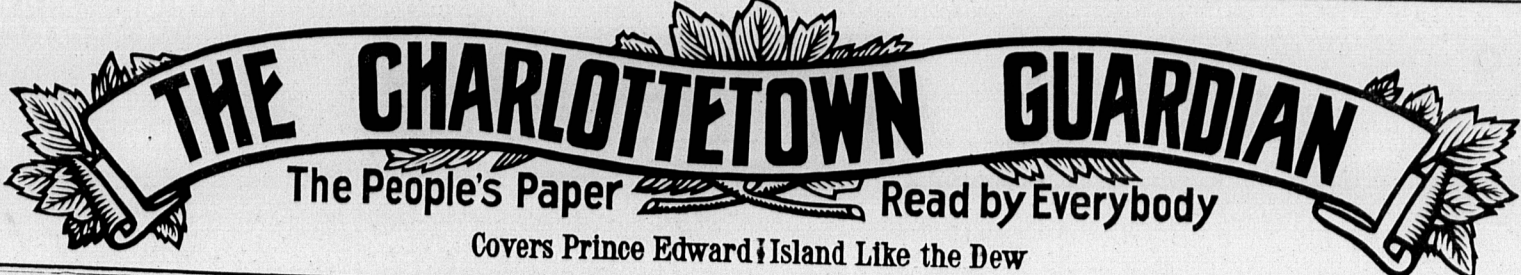

MESSAGE TO NATION

Following a conference lasting an hour and a half with ministers and defence chiefs at No. 10 Downing Street Mr. Churchill broadcast his message to the nation and it was rebroadcast internationally. He expressed confidence the stabilization of the western front would be achieved, but solemnly warned:—"After this battle in France abates its force there will come the battle for our islands; they are all that Britain has, and all that Britain means. That will be the struggle."

CALLS FOR SUPREME EFFORT

The Prime Minister, in his first broadcast since he assumed office, called on every man and woman in the nation for a supreme effort in this hour of danger, and renewed his pledge of his all-party Government "to wage war until victory is won, and never to surrender ourselves to servitude and shame, whatever the cost and the agony may be."

SOUNDS WARNING

Analyzing the situation caused by the infiltration of German mechanized forces through French divisions holding the western front, Mr. Churchill warned: "The armies must cast away the idea of resisting attack behind concrete lines or natural obstacles, and must realize that mastery can only be regained by furious and unrelenting assault, and this spirit must not only animate the High Command but must inspire every fighting man."
