NOTES ON THE CHARLOTTETOWN EGG LAYING CONTEST

The third Prince Edward Island Egg Laying Contest completed its second week with only 4 pens laying. The pen of White Leghorns owned by Mr. Edwin Reid of Rollo Bay, led, with 14 eggs. Mr. Percy Mutch's pen of White Leghorns started laying with two eggs; a pen of White Leghorns from the Experimental Station started, with 5 eggs, and a pen of Barred Rocks started with 1 egg. During the third week, ending November 21, Mr. Edwin Reid's pen laid 11 eggs, the two pens from the Experimental Station mentioned the previous week laid 7 to 5 eggs respectively. Mr. Percy Mutch's pen laid one egg; while the pen of Barred Rocks of Mr. J. B. Millman of Kensington, and the pen of White Leghorns of Mr. William Neale of Bear River started with 3 eggs each. At the close of the 4th week, ending November 28, Mr. Edwin Reid's pen of White Leghorns had reached a total of 52 eggs, laying 17 during the week. The pen of Mr. Percy Mutch of Mount Herbert, laying 16 eggs, and having a total of 19 eggs to date. Mr. J. B. Millman's pen of Barred Rocks laid 11 eggs. Mr. H. L. Machon's pen of Barred Rocks started with 7 eggs for the week. Mr. William Neale's pen of White Leghorns laid 5, the Experimental Station's pen of White Leghorns laid 5, and the Barred Rocks laid 6. The pen of White Wyandottes of Mrs. J. J. McLellan, of Grand River started laying with 4 eggs for the week; the pen of H. S. Moase of Kensington also started laying with 4 eggs for the week, and the pen of Mrs. R. C. McLaren have started, with 3 eggs for the week. The pens are starting and continuing well, and are already 45 eggs ahead of last year's contest. The total eggs laid during the week was 83, total eggs to date 143.

HUNS FLOCKING TO MEXICO

German immigration to Mexico is rapid, 100 families having arrived at Vera Cruz in the latter part of October. They were preceded by several other hundred families, most of whom settled in the state of Chiapas, where they are engaged in agriculture.
