M.A.H.A. Severs Relations With Amateur Body

MONCTON, N. B., May 19.—The adoption of new regulations of the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association and the re-election of Gordon T. Dowell, Middleton, N. B., as president of the Maritime Amateur Hockey Association, featured the M. A. H. A. annual meeting here today. Frank J. Gallagher, Moncton and A. E. Harris, Summerside, P. E. I., were named presidents.

The M. A. H. A. dropped from its executive the president and secretary of the Maritime Provincial Branch of the Amateur Athletic Union of Canada, thus severing connections with the amateur body and assuming the new definition of an amateur as laid down by the parent body.

A feature of the new constitution adopted at tonight's meetings, which followed a somewhat stormy afternoon session, is that the residence rule of Jan. 1 is abandoned, and Oct. 15 substituted, thereby allowing importation of players up to and including that date.

Lone Maritime Fighter Ousted

MONTRÉAL, May 19.—(CP)—Lean Gerald Farren of Saint John, lone Maritime in the Dominion Amateur Boxing Championships, met his master tonight in the flyweight semi-final and lost a three round decision to young Joe Gagnon of Montreal.

Farren and the 15 year old Quebec Provincial Champion provided one of the best fights of the night. There was no doubt about the decision however, little Gagnon pounding out his edge after Farren had held him off with his longer reach through the first two rounds.

Two Caught In Getaway Get Jail Term

Swift justice was meted out yesterday to Bruce Hecker, Indian River and Edmund Arsenault, Tryon, who were arrested at Cape Tormentine when the Car Ferry docked about 10.40 a. m., as they were trying to make a getaway, and commenced serving a jail term of twelve months in the Prince County jail at 3.30 p. m. that same afternoon. They were charged with breaking, entering and theft, in connection with a robbery at the store of Mr. E. Vernon MacLeod, merchant at Albany, some time the previous night.

Mr. MacLeod discovered the break when he went to open the store at seven a. m. He immediately notified Constable Arthur of the R. C. M. P. at Bordentown, who came at once to the store. He found that a window at the rear of the building which comprised a warehouse as well as a pane of glass removed. The thieves had evidently gained entrance that way. They found the safe open, (Mr. MacLeod said that by a strange coincidence it was the first time for over ten years that he had forgotten to lock the safe).

Mr. MacLeod stated that over forty dollars had been taken partly in bills and partly silver, some taken from the till. The culprits had left by the front door.

Constable MacArthur studied the footprints and noticed a peculiar rubber mark. He at once made for the Car Ferry and after some inquiries found that two suspicious characters had come aboard early that morning. They were evidently in hiding, although they had bought their tickets and had breakfast. With the cooperation of the Ferry officials they were caught as they were leaving at Cape Tormentine. They were searched and found to have secreted the bills in the cuffs of their trousers, and their hiding places. Thirty eight dollars was found on them. The constable also examined their shoes and found similar marks as he had found round the store. They confessed, were brought before Magistrate Darby at the Court House, Summerside, pleaded guilty, and elected to be tried summarily, and each given a sentence of one year in the county jail which began that afternoon.

Increased Assessment Tax Is Announced At Meeting Of Town Council

Councillor McKay Stresses Need For Increase, As Recommended By Recorder, To Cover Estimates For The Year.

The most important announcement made by the Summerside Town Council at its adjourned meeting on Tuesday night was that they were obliged to raise the assessment rate from \$15.00 to \$16.00 per \$100.

Councillor MacKay in making this announcement, said, they were compelled to do this because in our present Incorporation Act (which is obsolete) the assessment must cover the estimates for the year and as the Council does not see how it can reduce the estimates we must therefore raise the assessment.

Councillor MacKay wished it to be clearly understood that the Council have been compelled to adopt this course on the decision of the Recorder, whose letter on the subject is given in this report. Councillor MacKay said this clears the skirts of the Mayor and Councillors and the onus remains by the decision of the Recorder.

Recorders Letter Regarding Assessment Tax

The Mayor and Councillors, Town of Summerside, Prince Edward Island, Gentlemen:

By the newspaper reports I understand the Town Council has raised the Poll Tax to four dollars and twenty-five cents (\$4.25) and budgeted for a deficit.

May I say that, in my opinion, this would have the effect of making the whole assessment illegal and of no effect. As a very serious matter, I thought it my duty to bring the attention of your Council to same at the earliest possible opportunity, because it would involve serious consequences to the Town if the assessment would be abortive.

On turning up the Incorporation Act, I find that by Section 86 the Poll Tax shall be rated and assessed in the sum not exceeding three dollars (\$3.00) annually for school and Town purposes and by Section 34 of the Summerside Water and Sewerage Act, a Poll Tax not exceeding one dollar (\$1.00) in addition to any Poll Tax now levied by the town, may be levied and collected in each year, but this is only confined to pay for water and Sewerage Debentures. That is now the 25 cents is levied in addition to the three dollars as at present.

Under the provisions of your Summerside Incorporation Act, the estimates are made up as an assessment made to cover the amount required for various Town purposes, annually, but, in my opinion, the Sections in the Act are mandatory and a full assessment should be made for any amount required by the town for the various purposes, that is clear of special expenditures authorized by the Legislature by the issuing of Debentures.

It is customary for the Recorder not to give his opinion until asked for same, but as it would be a serious matter to have your whole assessment illegal, I felt it my duty, as above stated, to bring these matters to your attention.
