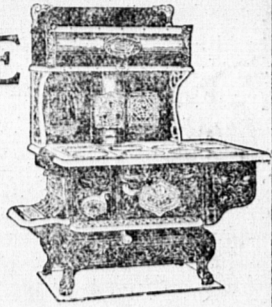

SUNDAY SCHOOL CONVENTION

YORK, P. E. I., — September 29.—The Charlottetown District Sunday School Convention of the Methodist Church met at York, Sept. 28th.

The afternoon session opened with a devotional half hour led by Rev. J. M. Rice.

In the absence of Rev. Wm. Harrison, Chairman of the District, Rev. F. A. Wightman the District S. S. secretary was appointed chairman and Rev. J. M. Rice, sec'y of the Convention.

A report as to the condition of the Sunday Schools of the District submitted by the S. S. Sec'y elicited a most interesting and profitable discussion, which resulted in the passing of the following resolution viz— That the attention of the Methodist Book Room be called to the fact that many of our Sunday Schools are using the Comprehensive Quarterly Scholars Edition issued by The Cook Publishing Co. the reason being given that this publication gives its lesson help in more succinct form and at a cheaper rate than the corresponding quarterly issued by the Book Room. They also direct attention to the fact that there seems to be a need, very generally felt for a special S. S. paper published specially for boys, and one specially for girls.

Rev. Mr. Orman addressed the convention on some important phases of the work.

Rev. S. T. Bartlett, Associate General Sec'y of S. S. and Epworth League of the Methodist Church, conducted a most helpful and instructive conference on S. S. work and methods.

Benediction by Rev. Hugh Miller brought the session to a close. The evening session opened with devotional exercises conducted by Rev. E. Bell. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

Rev. L. J. Wason gave a heart to heart talk on the responsibility of parents with regard to the training of their children. The S. S. was to supplement not to take the place of home training.

Rev. S. F. Bartlett, addressed the convention. His subject Better Bible Study, was presented in a very able and practical manner.

Resolutions in appreciation of the official visit of Rev. Mr. Bartlett to the District, also in appreciation of the friends at York in entertaining the delegates, were unanimously passed, after which a convention most helpful to all was closed with the benediction by the chairman.
