Bull Market

Four Years Old

NEW YORK, April 22—(AP)— The big bull stock market, four years old today, finished a generally losing week Saturday with specialized recoveries dominating the session.

It was on April 28, 1942, that the list began its third lengthiest ascent on record which has been punctuated only by minor interruptions.

While individual favorites in Saturday's short session jumped three points or so on notably "thin" transactions, many pivots found the going a bit difficult. Advances, however, were well in the majority at the close. Demand for utilities persisted.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was up 3 of a point but on the week showed a net drop of 12 points, widest for any similar period since that concluded March 19, 1942.

Among the day's best movers, spurred by the sales and profits outlook, were Montgomery Ward, up 3 1-8 at \$93.36; United Biscuit, up 3 1-8 at \$87.75; Western Union, up 3 1-8 at \$106.25; and Bethlehem 2 1-2 at \$106.25.

Ahead fractions to a point or so were U.S. Steel, General Motors, Chrysler, U.S. Rubber, North American, Electric Power and Light, American Water Works, Columbia Gas, American Power, Sears Roebuck, Anacoda, Kennecott Phelps Dodge, American Can, Westinghouse, Hazel-Atlas Glass (on the first extra dividend in years), Third Avenue Transit (buoyed again by refinancing talk) Standard Oil (N.J.), Texas Co., Southern Railway, Great Northern and Southern Railway.

Douglas Aircraft was off 1-1-2. Other losers included United Air, great National Biscuit, Lockheed, Republic Aviation, Dow Chemical, Northern Pacific International, Harvester, and Consolidated Edison.

Canadian Stocks showed strength with Distillers Seagram up 3 at McIntyre up 1, Dome Mines gained 1-4. Canadian Pacific eased 1-8.
