J. D. RAMSAY of Sinclair & Stewart leaves today for Toronto to attend the exhibition. He will be accompanied by Mrs. Ramsay.

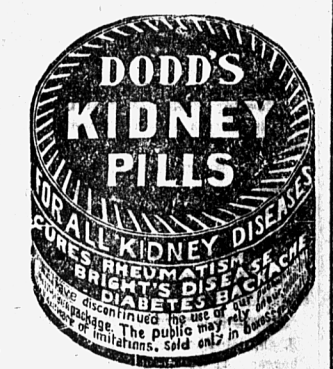
