OTTAWA, Feb. 26.—Consideration was promised today by Hon. Alfred Durand, Acting Minister of Fisheries, to a delegation seeking changes in the salmon fishing regulations on the Miramichi River, N. B.

Removal of the so-called dead-line which now runs between Esquimaux breakwater and Negus back to the Mar. 1930 dead-line which ran from Esquimaux light-house to Tavusintac was asked for in briefs presented by Newcastle members of the delegation.

Reduction in the number of fish-oms for drift nets, stopping of the issue of further licenses and the gradual reduction of existing salmon fishing licenses also were sought.

New Brunswick members in the Dominion Parliament were present with T. H. Whalen and John Greighan, Newcastle, representing the Miramichi Fishermen's Association and the Newcastle branch of the New Brunswick Fish and Game Association. F. C. Cooper of the New Brunswick Fish and Game Association and C. H. Ritchie, Chief Game Warden attended.

Lone Woman Explorer Returns From Arctic Circle

HALIFAX, Feb. 25.—Isobel H. Hutchison doesn't mind the cold up in the Arctic Circle.

On the trip she has just concluded she became the first white woman to enter Canada by way of Demarcation Point, far up on Yukon's rugged north shore.

Miss Hutchison, who looks more like a school teacher than a collector of Arctic specimens, explained for the ladies' motions or so she had been in Alaska, gathering flora for the Royal Herbarium of Kew and Eskimo curios for the Museum of Ethnology at Cambridge, England.

"It's the moisture"
Not once in that time did she have a cold. Then she went to New York on the way to England.

And she caught a cold. She still had it when she arrived here today on the Cunard liner Albatross. "It's the moisture," she explained, somewhat shamefacedly, to the reporters.

The air is dry in the north, and there is little tendency to colds. Miss Hutchison, a wife of a woman of perhaps 40 years, was taking no chances in Halifax. She left the liner to go to church this morning, but she was wrapped warmly in an Eskimo parka of reindeer skin, with a wolfskin hood. Around her feet were huge "mukluks" of the soft reindeer fur.

She shed the parka to talk to the reporters. But she clung to the mukluks. "I like this outfit," she said. "I've been wearing it for so long I feel lost without it." And she has been wearing it quite a while now, for she is no newcomer to the northland.

Lone Explorer
She spent a year and a half in Greenland, and she has had plenty of a feminine explorer in regions where few white women had set foot before. And she is perhaps the only woman who ventures into

things in his hands. With this increased confidence in God will come a deeper distrust in self. Many of us are as we blunder our way through life go about it as though we were able to move mountains, and that God could only be counted on for the molehills. By this time many of us might reverse the order. A humbler opinion of "it" would help a whole lot toward "imitating" the worries of life. Phantom Ship
In the Beaufort Sea, too, Miss Hutchison encountered, and was the first woman to board the North's phantom ship—the derelict Hudson's Bay Company vessel Baychimo, adrift in the fogs since she broke anchor off Wainwright three years ago.

The ghostly craft was sighted through the northern mists as the schooner Miss Hutchison had chartered came off Wainwright last August. The schooner crept through a "lead" in the ice to the huge floe on which the derelict lay almost out of water, and Miss Hutchison and the seaman went aboard—second visitors since she was cast adrift.
